

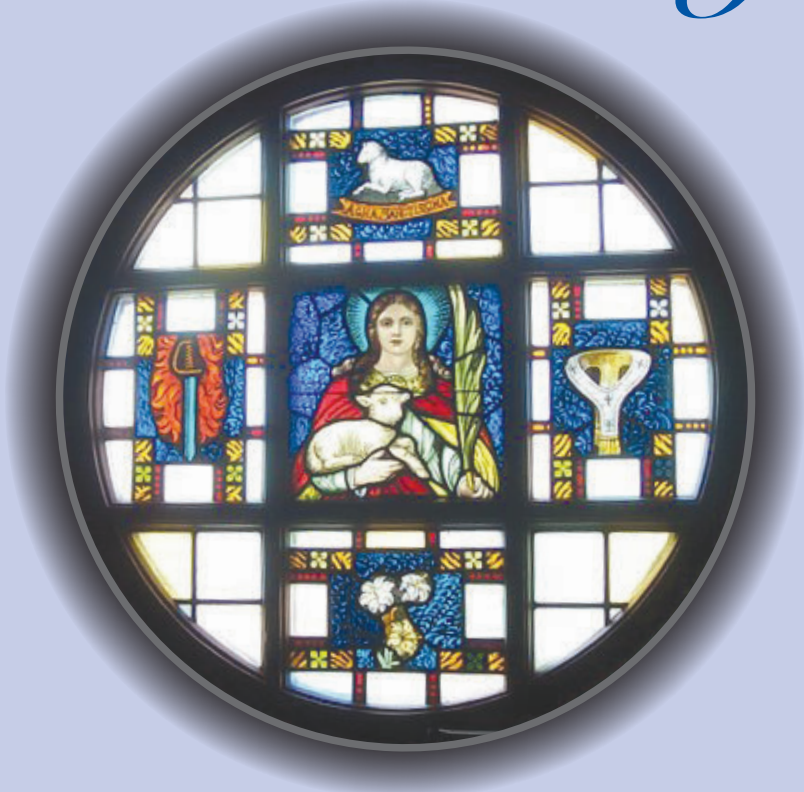

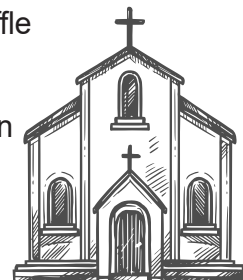

Please know that, whoever you are and from wherever you have come, you are welcome in God's house. May every heart be warmed by God's presence.

ALL SOULS DAY

November 2nd is All Souls Day, a day the Church encourages us to remember our deceased loved ones in a special way. There is an "All Souls envelope" in your packet of church envelopes. This is not for your regular church donation.

The All Souls envelope provides space to write the names of your deceased family and friends. If there is not enough room on the envelope for all the names you would like remembered at the Masses, just insert a sheet of paper inside the envelope with any additional names. You may put an offering in the envelope, but you do not have to put anything inside.

Drop the envelope in the collection basket in the next several weeks or return them to the Rectory or Parish Office. The envelopes will be placed at the altar in Church and remain there during the entire month of November.

On All Souls Day, celebrated on a Sunday this year—November 2nd—all the Sunday/weekend Masses will be offered for the names listed on the envelopes.

Also, a special Mass will be offered for "All Souls"—our loved ones—each week during November. In the following months, from December to next October, at least one Mass will be offered for "All Souls" each month. If you do not have an All Souls envelope, there will be additional ones in the back vestibule of the Church.
