# ALL SOULS DAY

November 2<sup>nd</sup> is All Souls Day, a day the Church encourages us to remember our deceased loved ones in a special way. There is an "All Souls envelope" in your packet of church envelopes. This is not for your regular church donation.

The All Souls envelope provides space to write the names of your deceased family and friends. If there is not enough room on the envelope for all the names you would like remembered at the Masses, just insert a sheet of paper inside the envelope with any additional names. You may put an offering in the envelope, but you do not have to put anything inside.

Drop the envelope in the collection basket in the next several weeks or return them to the Rectory or Parish Office. The envelopes will be placed at the altar in Church and remain there during the entire month of November.

On All Souls Day, celebrated on a Sunday this year—November 2<sup>nd</sup>—all the Sunday/weekend Masses will be offered for the names listed on the envelopes.

Also, a special Mass will be offered for "All Souls"our loved ones-each week during November. In the following months, from December to next October, at least one Mass will be offered for "All Souls" each month. If you do not have an All Souls envelope, there will be additional ones in the back vestibule of the Church.

**PRAYERFUL REMEMBRANCE** — Beginning All Souls Day, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, we will put the "Book of Prayerful Remembrance" in front of the church. This book contains death notices of parishioners who have died since All Saints Day 2004. You might take the time to look through the book and remember the people listed and their families in your prayers. After the book is in the front of the church for a few weeks it will be returned to the back vestibule.

The Church celebrates All Saints Day each year on November 1st. On All Saints Day, the Church honors all the saints in heaven, not only the canonized saints, but also members of our families who already enjoy the happiness of heaven. This year All Saints Day is on a Saturday. Although normally a holy day of obligation, since it falls on a Saturday this year you are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass. We will still have two Masses. There will be a Vigil Mass on Friday, October 31st at 5:15 p.m. as well as a morning Mass on Saturday, November 1st at 8:15 a.m.

Consider attending Mass on All Saints Day even though you are not obligated to this year. Attend to honor those who have gone before us, and to focus your attention on our heavenly goal.
