



ASH WEDNESDAY—Lent begins on Wednesday of this week - Ash Wednesday.

Ashes will be blessed and distributed in the middle of Mass (after the gospel and homily) this Wednesday, February 18th Masses - 8:15 a.m. and Evening Service at 7:00 p.m. on Ash Wednesday for your convenience.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION — *“For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.”*
MATTHEW 5:20

The Pharisees lived according to the letter of the law, and they used this to elevate themselves above the other people. Jesus is clear – it’s the love that you have in your heart, for God and others, that will get you to heaven. Simply following church rules to the letter and not out of love, does not necessarily put you on the path to heaven. Mondays - Vespers/Evening Prayer at 6:45 p.m.


Thursdays - Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament 8:45 a.m. to 8:45 p.m., Benediction - 8:45 p.m.

THE ROSARY—The rosary is prayed most weekday mornings after the 8:15 a.m. Mass. All are welcome and encouraged to come and pray the Rosary. A reminder that there are sheets available in the back vestibule of the church with a step-by-step explanation of the praying of the Rosary.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS—

Each Friday of Lent, the stations are prayed here at St. Agnes at 7:00 p.m. Stations last about 30 minutes. All are encouraged to attend and reflect on the suffering of Jesus.

VESPERS—Evening prayer or “vespers” is being prayed at St. Agnes Church on the Mondays of Lent at 6:45 p.m. Vespers only take about ten or fifteen minutes. It consists largely of psalms recited with other scripture passages.

All are welcome, and books are available in church on Mondays for you to join in and participate.

FISH FRY—Parishioners are invited to attend the Lenten Fish Fry from 5:00-6:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall on Friday’s during Lent (February 20th - March 20th) Dine in or take out—\$11 for adults, and \$6 for children.



FAST—Catholics from the age of 18 to 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The Lenten fast means that a person would only eat one larger meal and two smaller meals. Drinking liquids between meals does not break the fast.

ABSTINENCE—Catholics 14 and older are required to abstain from meat and meat products (soups w/meat, meat gravies, etc.) on the designated days. Days of abstinence are Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
