



LENT AT ST. AGNES

FAST—Catholics from the age of 18 to 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday (February 18th) and Good Friday (April 3rd.) The Lenten fast means that a person would only eat one larger meal and two smaller meals. Drinking liquid between meals does not break the fast.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS*—Each Friday of Lent, the stations are prayed here at St. Agnes at 7:00 p.m. Stations last about 30 minutes. All are encouraged to attend and reflect on the suffering of Jesus.


ABSTINENCE—Catholics 14 and older are required to abstain from meat and meat products (soups with meat, meat gravies, etc.) on the designated days. Days of Abstinence are Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.

FISH FRY—Parishioners are invited to attend the Lenten Fish Fry from 5:00-6:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall on Friday’s during Lent (February 20th - March 20th) Dine in or take out—\$11 for adults, and \$6 for children.

*Stations of the Cross

Telling the story of the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus was an important part of the early Christian’s experience. In the late fourth century, people began making pilgrimages to the Holy Land, where they would follow the path that Jesus took to Calvary. During the Middle Ages, when outbreaks of war made it impossible for people to travel to the Holy Land, people created a Via Dolorosa, or “Sorrowful Way,” in their towns and villages. They erected paintings or sculptures depicting the Passion of the Christ along a processional route or inside a church. By the mid-18th century, the number of stations was fixed at 14 and the devotion known as the Stations of the Cross, also called the Way of the Cross, became widespread.
