

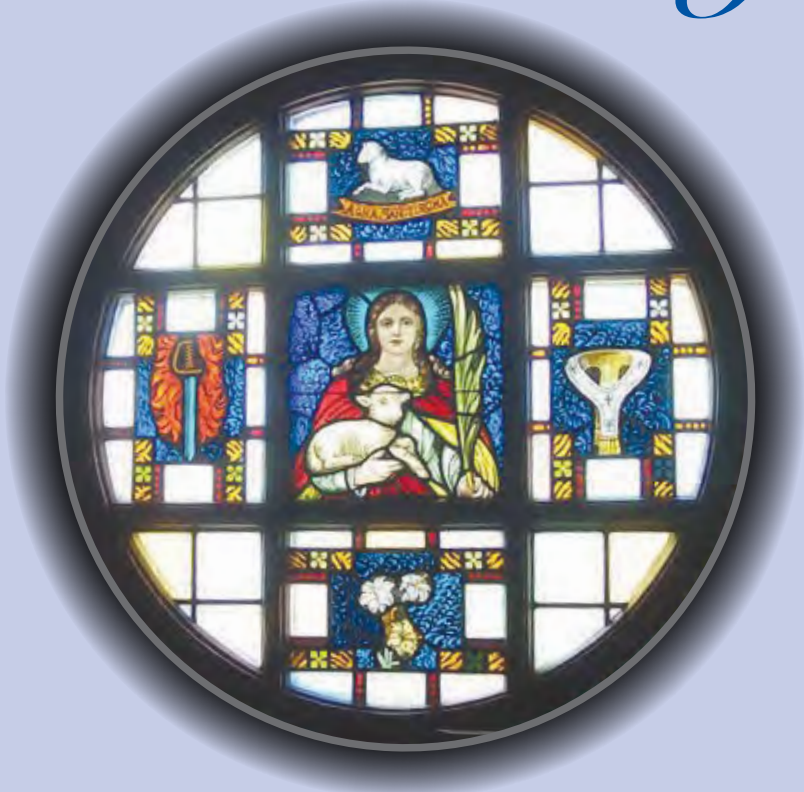

During the next several weeks, this water is the “Easter Water” blessed at the Easter Vigil Mass, but regular holy water is also available throughout the year. For the next several weeks the holy water will be in the sanctuary (altar area) in the stainless-steel container. During the rest of the year, this same container of holy water is in the side door vestibule. Just bring a small jar or bottle and fill it up from the spigot on the holy water container.
