

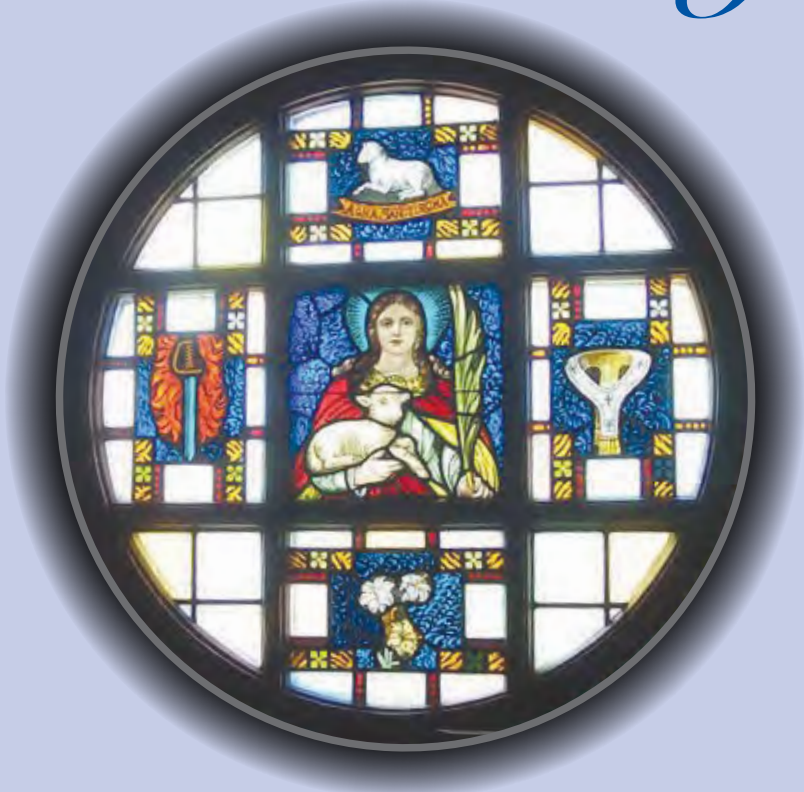

May 10th will be our last PSR class for the 2025-2026 School Year & also the **May Crowning**. Families are invited to attend & bring flowers to present to the Blessed Mother. *1st Communion students will receive their scapulars during the May Crowning.*

DONUT SUNDAY — Our last donut Sunday (until Fall) will be held on May 10th during PSR in the Parish Center.

EASTER HOLY WATER—We remind you that you may obtain holy water at church for your use at home. During the next several weeks, this water is the “Easter Water” blessed at the Easter Vigil Mass, but regular holy water is also available throughout the year. For the next several weeks the holy water will be in the sanctuary (altar area) in the stainless-steel container. During the rest of the year, this same container of holy water is in the side door vestibule. Just bring a small jar or bottle and fill it up from the spigot on the holy water container.
