

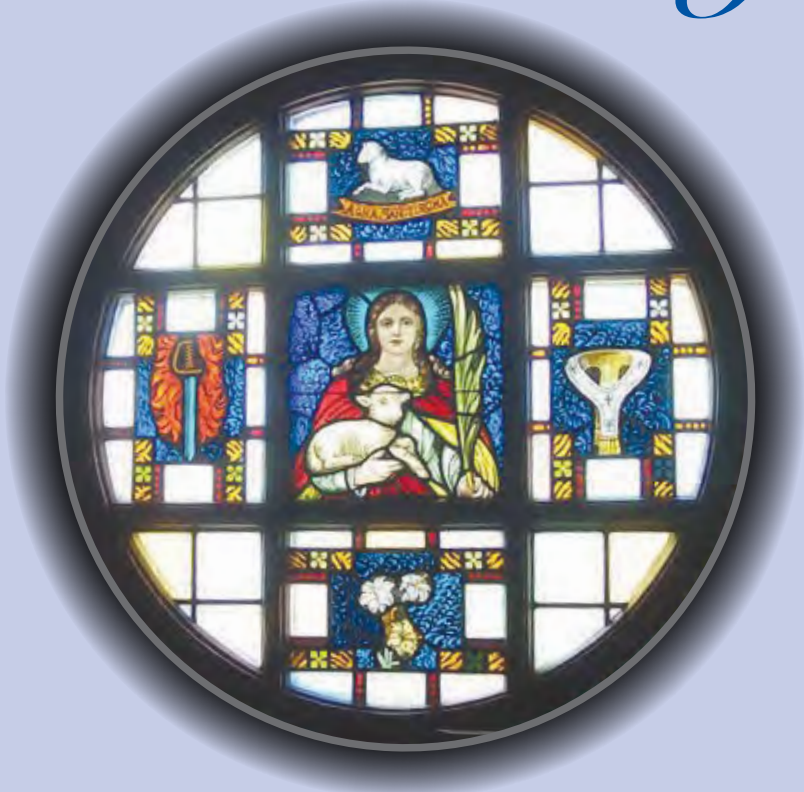

WEEKLY REMINDER — If you are able to, visit the graves of your loved ones. If you have young children take them with you so that one day they may visit your grave. When you go to the grave, remember to offer a prayer for the deceased person.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION — *“And Peter said to them, ‘Repent, and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ...’” ACTS 2:38*

The word “repent” means to turn from sin - to change our thoughts, words and actions. Change that is permanent comes from within – a transformation or conversion of heart. This requires stewardship, prayer, discipline and perseverance. Change is hard. The first step is recognizing that we are broken and that we need God’s help. The good news - we are not alone in our journey. Ask Jesus daily for guidance and patiently listen for his response.

PSR NEWS — If you have a child receiving their first communion please note these upcoming important dates: April 26th-1st Communion Practice for 2nd Grade Students +1 Parent during PSR. **May 3rd-1st Communion** will be held at the 11:30 a.m. Mass.

May 10th will be our last PSR class for the 2025-2026 School Year & also the **May Crowning**. Families are invited to attend & bring flowers to present to the Blessed Mother. *1st Communion students will receive their scapulars during the May Crowning.*

DONUT SUNDAY — Our last donut Sunday (until Fall) will be held on May 10th during PSR in the Parish Center.

EASTER HOLY WATER—We remind you that you may obtain holy water at church for your use at home. During the next several weeks, this water is the “Easter Water” blessed at the Easter Vigil Mass, but regular holy water is also available throughout the year. For the next several weeks the holy water will be in the sanctuary (altar area) in the stainless-steel container. During the rest of the year, this same container of holy water is in the side door vestibule.

Just bring a small jar or bottle and fill it up from the spigot on the holy water container.
