

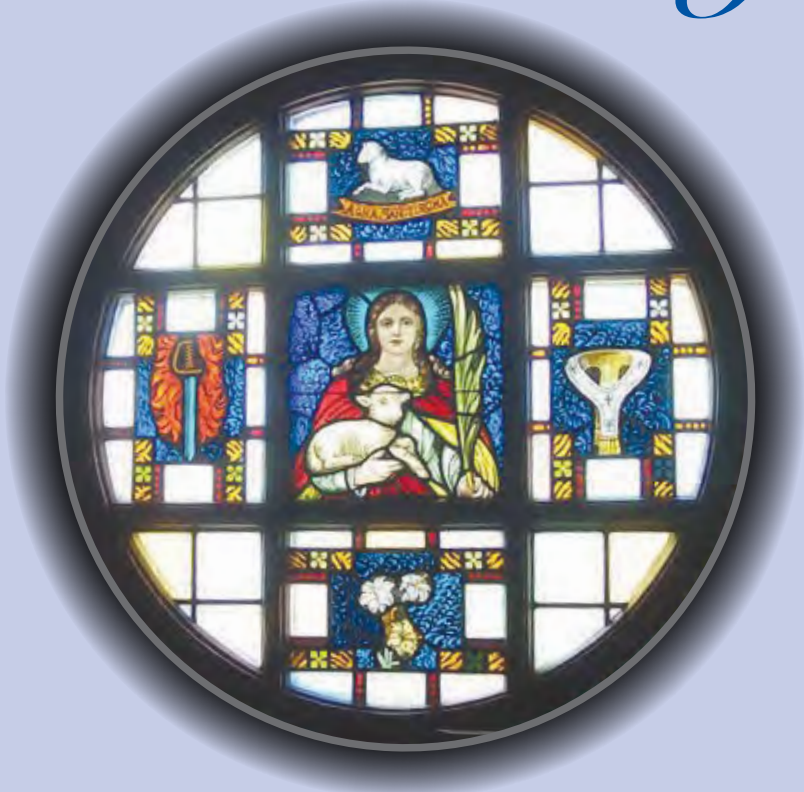

## May is the Month of Mary

May has traditionally been considered the month of Mary, the mother of Jesus. Give special honor to the Blessed Virgin Mary during this coming May, even if it is only by saying/praying a “Hail Mary” to yourself. Another prayer that is sometimes prayed in honor of Mary is the “Memorare.”

**Memorare** — Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never has it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother, to thee do I come before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy, hear and answer me. Amen.

**Rosary** — The Rosary is prayed every morning after the 8:15 a.m. Mass. It is also prayed once a month at 8:15 p.m. on Thursday evenings before the First Friday of the month. All are welcome to join in the praying of the Rosary. *Also, if you wish detailed information about how to pray the Rosary, there are sheets available for you to take in the back of the church.*
