

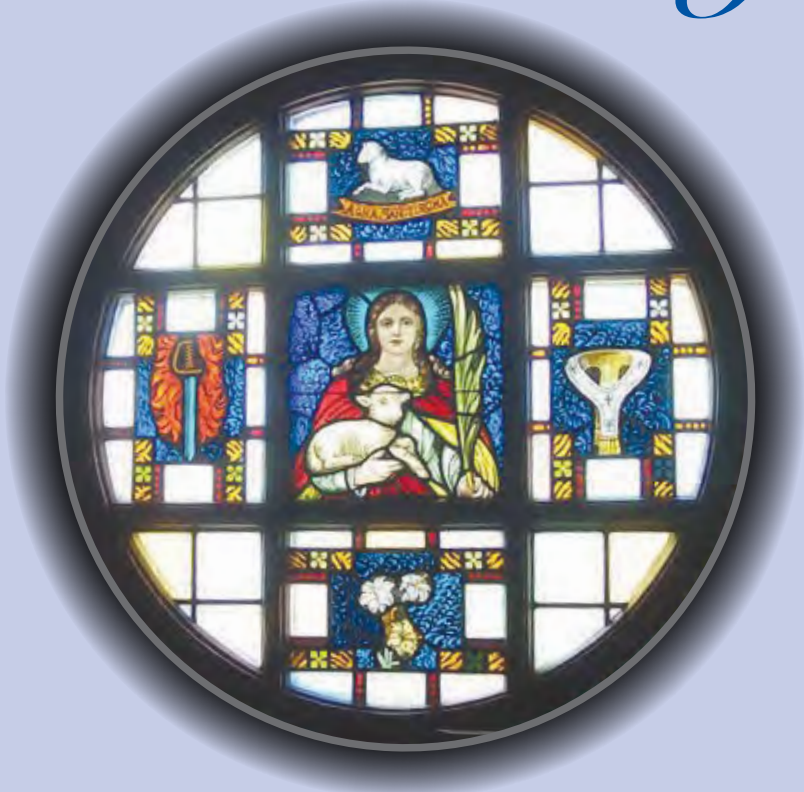

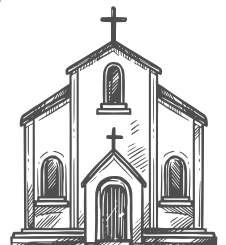

*May is the Month of Mary*

May has traditionally been considered the month of Mary, the mother of Jesus. Give special honor to the Blessed Virgin Mary during this coming May, even if it is only by saying/praying a “Hail Mary” to yourself. Another prayer that is sometimes prayed in honor of Mary is the “Memorare.”

**Memorare** — Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never has it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother, to thee do I come before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy, hear and answer me. Amen.

**Rosary** — The Rosary is prayed every morning after the 8:15 a.m. Mass. It is also prayed once a month at 8:15 p.m. on Thursday evenings before the First Friday of the month. **PRAYER** — A prayer of an English Dominican priest, Fr. Bede Jarrett, O.P., expresses the importance of viewing death with the eyes of faith. Fr. Jarrett’s prayer is as follows:

We seem to give them back to thee, O God, who gavest them to us. Yet, as thou didst not lose them in giving, so do we not lose them by their return. Not as the world giveth, givest thou, O lover of souls. What thou givest, thou takest no away, for what is thine is ours also if we are thine. Lift us up, strong Son of God, that we may see further; cleanse our eyes that we may see more clearly; draw us closer to thyself that we may know ourselves to be nearer to our loved ones who art with thee.
