

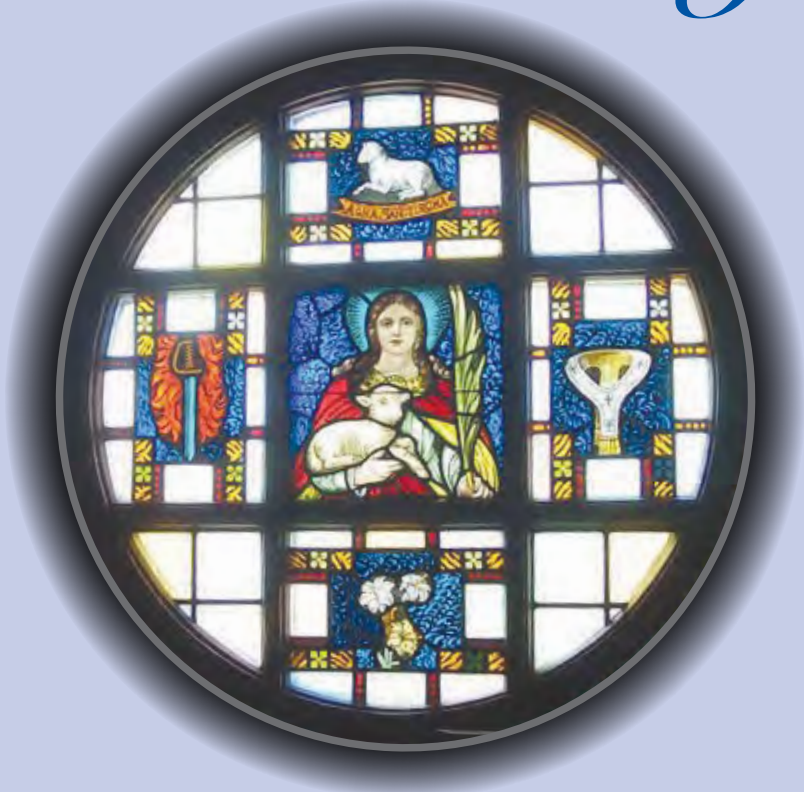

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION — "...whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me." Matthew 10:38

Pope Benedict XVI said "The world offers you comfort. But you were not made for comfort, you were made for greatness". "Comfort" puts me first. "Picking up your cross and following Jesus" puts God and others first. Why settle for comfort when you can achieve greatness! Pick up your cross, ask Jesus for guidance on using your gifts and live the life God intended for you!

SUMMER MASSES — We remind you that there should not be a "vacation" from God during the summer. Of course, we should turn to God in prayer each day, but of paramount importance is the obligation to "Keep Holy the Lord's Day" by attending Mass each Sunday. To facilitate this obligation for Sunday Mass we remind you: If you are traveling and looking for a Mass, you can always make use of the website www.masstimes.org to find the Mass schedule at a nearby Catholic Church. If you make use of this website, it might be good to phone once you are in the area to make sure that the Mass schedule has not changed.

SUMMER — Prayer - With summer about to begin, please try to remember to make God a part of your life, even though you might be on vacation, remember the importance of attending Sunday Mass. Make getting to Sunday Mass a part of your travel plans. Also, offer to God your own prayers each day in addition to Sunday Mass. Try also to make use of the Sacrament of Penance (Confession) during the summer.

VISITING MISSION APPEAL — Each year a representative of a missionary group is assigned to parishes to speak at Masses to ask for support of their mission work in spreading the Gospel.
