

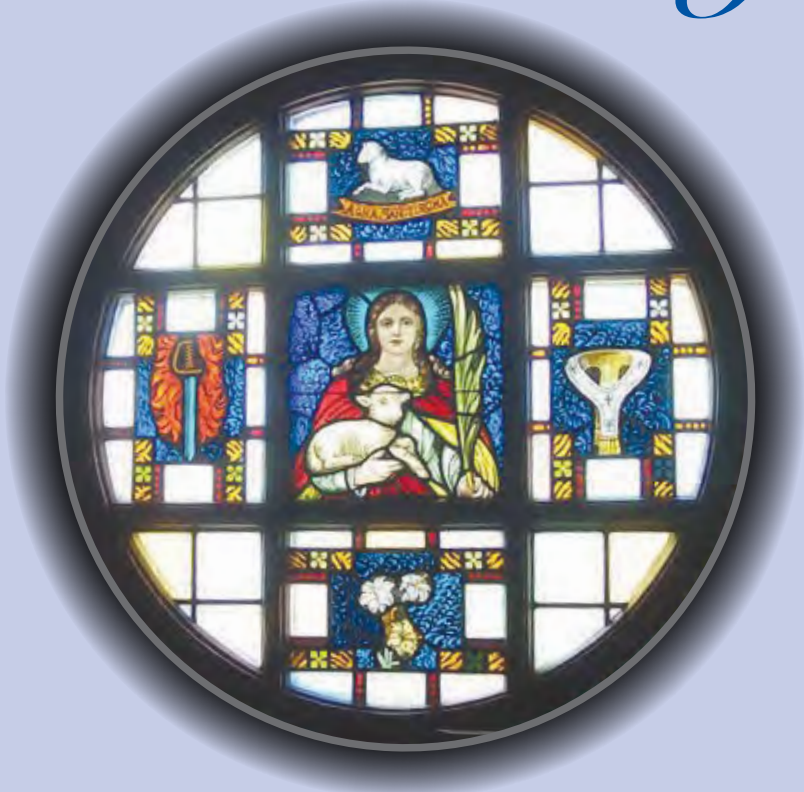

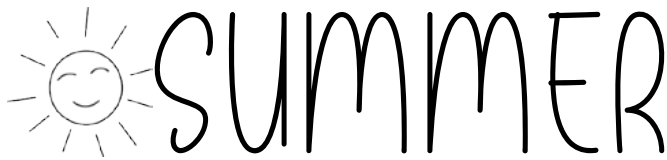


**WEEKLY REMINDER** — Offer a prayer for those who are out of work, and that all of us may strive to do well in work that we undertake.

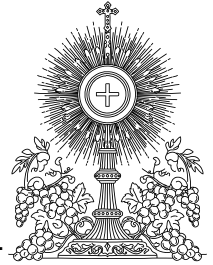
**1. Prayer** - With summer about to begin, please try to remember to make God a part of your life, even though you might be on vacation, remember the importance of attending Sunday Mass. Make getting to Sunday Mass a part of your travel plans. Also, offer to God your own prayers each day in addition to Sunday Mass. Try also to make use of the Sacrament of Penance (Confession) during the summer.

**2. Church Envelopes** - Generally, many of you are generous in the church collection envelopes throughout the year. Thank you. During the summer, however, when people are on vacation there is often a drop in collection. Please try to remember that there are continued expenses throughout the summer. If you go away on vacation, please consider using your church envelopes from that time you are away and dropping several envelopes in when you return.

**3. Dress/Attire** - When the hotter days of summer come upon us, many times people’s clothing styles change. When you come to church during the summer, please try to dress appropriately. Please do not wear clothes that are better suited for the beach. Remember that, whatever the temperature, our attire should reflect that we are coming to worship our Lord and Creator.

## CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

We will celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi in a special way once again this year. The feast, or rather the solemnity, of Corpus Christi -- The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ -- is celebrated in the United States on the second Sunday after Pentecost.



This means that this year we will be celebrating it **today, Sunday, June 7<sup>th</sup>**. The Sunday Mass Prayers and reading for Corpus Christi focus our attention on Jesus’ gift of Himself to us in the Eucharist. This is to be celebrated in each Catholic Church.

The special way that we hope to celebrate Corpus Christi this year is with an outdoor Eucharist procession. The procession will follow the 10:45 a.m. Sunday Mass. A Host consecrated during the Mass is placed in the monstrance after the Mass and usually carried in procession with candles and incense, often under a canopy. The procession proceeds to several stations or altars where the Eucharistic blessing or benediction is given. Litanies, readings and songs are generally a part of Eucharist procession is a more vivid expression of our love for Our Lord’s presence in the Eucharist and our desire to follow Him in our lives.
