

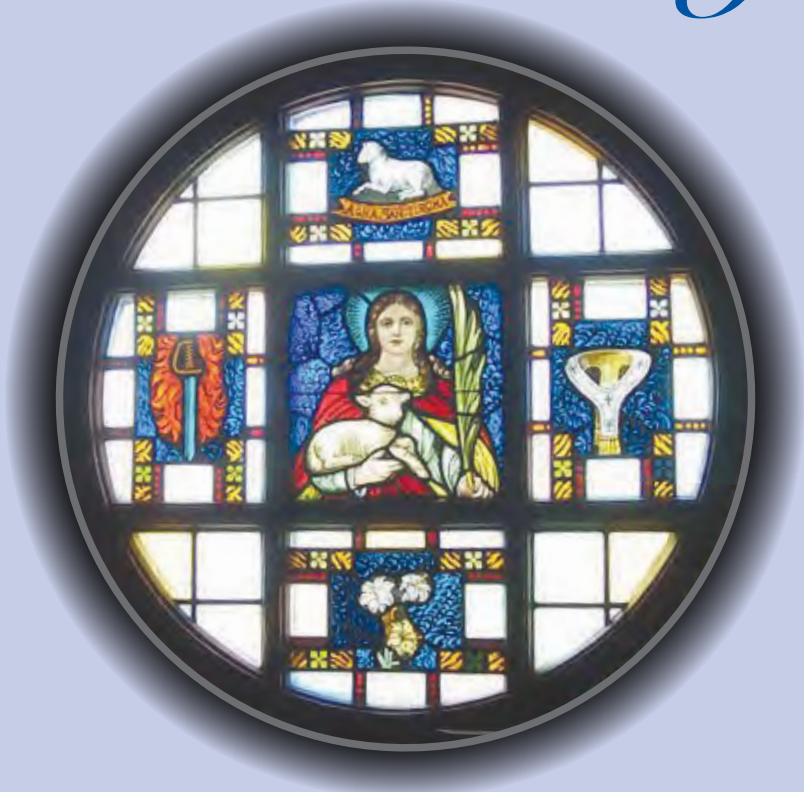

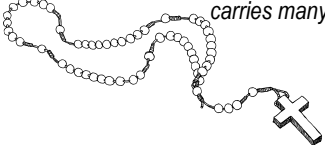

Do this in your own words, or by praying an act of contrition. But also remember to thank God for the blessings of the day.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION — “The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word but then the cares of the world and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit.” - MATTHEW 13:22

Does the lure of riches and material goods choke God out of your life? Are you so caught up in earthly activities that you have no time for God? Gratitude and generosity are **stewardship** virtues that we should strive to do on a daily basis. Every decision we make either takes us one step closer to God or one step further away. What we receive at Mass every Sunday should be shared with others all the other days of the week as well.

WELCOME

Hopefully, you always feel welcome at St. Agnes and at every Catholic church you might attend. We are one family in faith and each parish or church is home for every Catholic.

We also welcome non-Catholics to worship with us. There are occasions when people might be reluctant to attend Mass or feel that they are not welcome. One such occasion might be when parents come to church with children who are a bit young and restless. You should NOT let young children deter you from attending Mass. We share with you words that are from another Catholic Church, one in the Canton area:

To parents of young children:

May we suggest...Relax!

God put the wiggle in children. Don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!

Sit towards the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what is going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of others! Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, choir, and other ministers. Help them to find the hymns and prayers in the hymnals, and song sheets. Sing the hymns, pray, participate in the liturgy. Children learn about worship and liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me..."

Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.

To the members of our parish:

The **presence of children is a gift** to the church and a reminder that our congregation is growing. Please welcome our children and give a smile of encouragement to their parents.



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
