

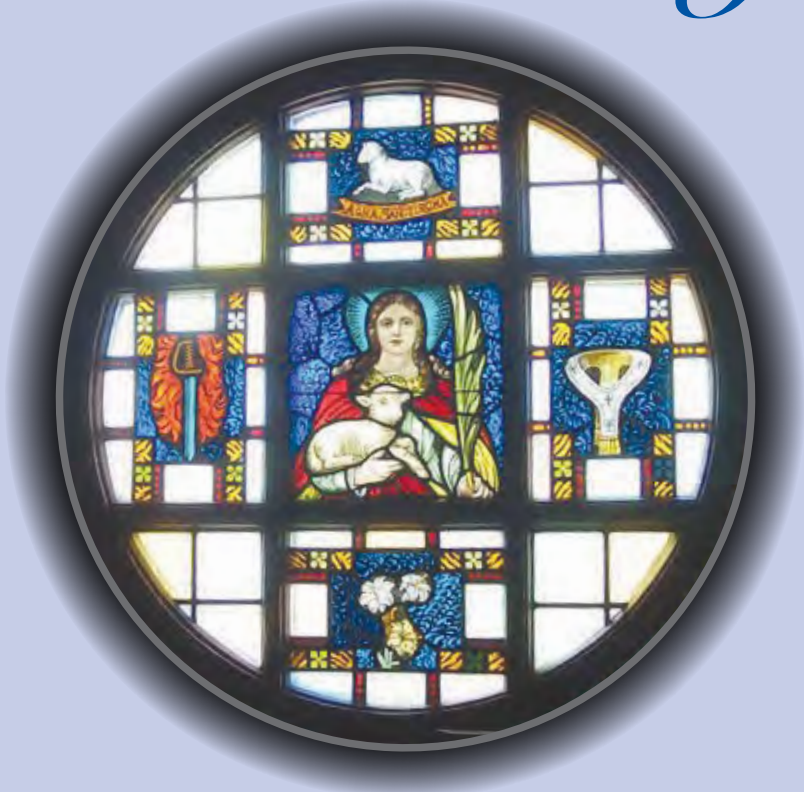

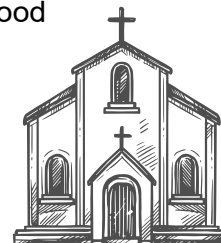

VIATORES CHRISTI LAY MISSIONARY ASSOCIATION

Sarah Oates, a member of Viatores Christi, will speak at Masses at St. Agnes on August 1st & 2nd, 2026 as part of the Cleveland Diocese Mission Cooperative Program.

What is Viatores Christi?

Viatores Christi means Travelers for Christ. It is a Catholic Lay Missionary Association, founded in Dublin, Ireland in 1960. The vision of Viatores Christi is a world of freedom, peace and justice, where everyone is empowered to live their lives with dignity, equality and respect. That they may have life and have it to the full. (John 10:10). Viatores Christi to date has sent over 2000 volunteers on mission to 50 countries.

Sarah Oates is from County Galway in the West of Ireland, and she is a widow, a mother of three adult sons and has two Grandchildren. She lived and worked as a lay missionary with the Franciscan Brothers in Uganda for 5 years and she continues to support their work both online and through occasional visits to East Africa. Sarah became a member of Viatores Christi in 2011 when she completed their volunteer training program and continues to support VC whenever she can. She is looking forward to visiting St Agnes Parish and Orrville, Ohio.
