

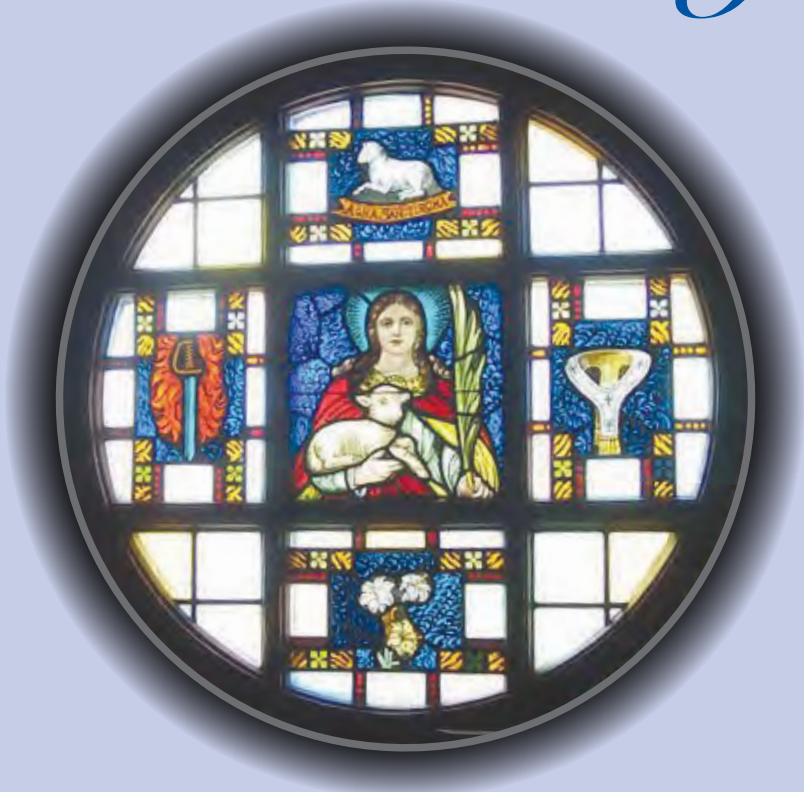

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION — *"For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."* - MATTHEW 11:30

When we think of being good **stewards**, we may think that God is asking too much of us when He calls us to generously share our time, talent and treasure. However, we must remember that we are not "owners" of anything, we are merely "**stewards**" of the gifts God has given us. All He is asking is that we give back a small portion, in gratitude, of what He has already given to us.

SUMMER MASSES — We remind you that there should not be a "vacation" from God during the summer. Of course, we should turn to God in prayer each day, but of paramount importance is the obligation to "Keep Holy the Lord's Day" by attending Mass each Sunday. SUMMER — Church Envelopes - Generally, many of you are generous in the church collection envelopes throughout the year. Thank you. During the summer, however, when people are on vacation there is often a drop in collection. Please try to remember that there are continued expenses throughout the summer. If you go away on vacation, please consider using your church envelopes from that time you are away and dropping several envelopes in when you return.

VISITING MISSION APPEAL — Each year a representative of a missionary group is assigned to parishes to speak at Masses to ask for support of their mission work in spreading the Gospel. Sarah Oates, a member of Viatores Christi, will speak at Masses at St. Agnes on August 1st and 2nd as part of the Cleveland Diocese Mission Cooperative Program.

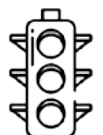
