

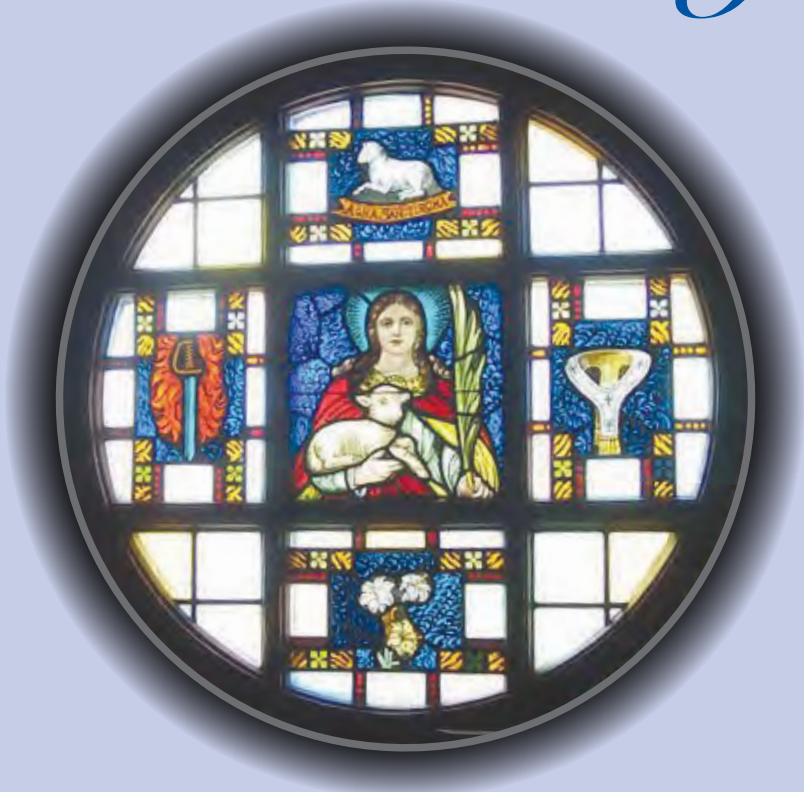

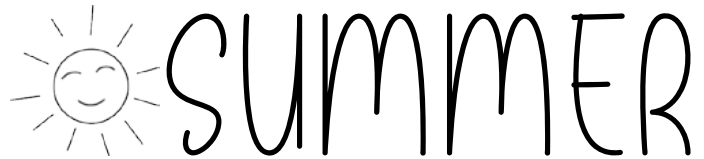
O God, Who wills not the death of a sinner *
