

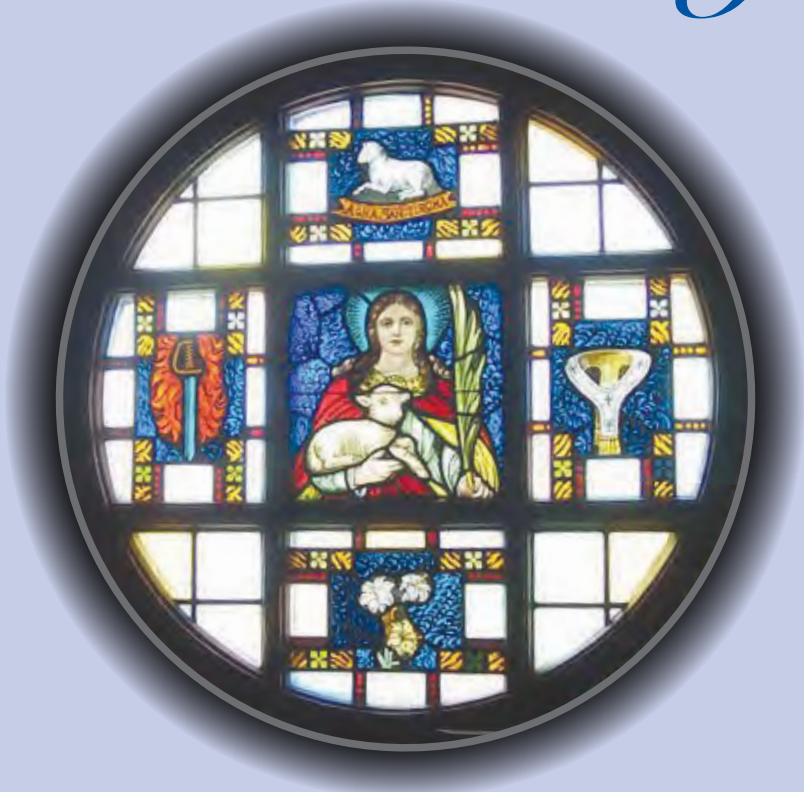

RIGHT TO LIFE—Right to Life of Stark County will be Celebrating Life at their annual “Celebrate Life Dinner” on Saturday, September 19, 2026. The speaker for the evening will be Jessica Rodgers, Coalitions Director for Patients Rights Action Fund.

Jessica will speak on Euthanasia and how we as a Pro-Life Organization can work to prevent assisted suicide laws from coming to our State and speak briefly on Medical Power of Attorney, and Living Wills. Jessica has a long history of advocacy work, running a program for college students with disabilities and prior experience in legislation and media. She also has an educational focus on human services and gerontology. Jessica works across the country to protect the vulnerable from the dangers of assisted suicide.
