

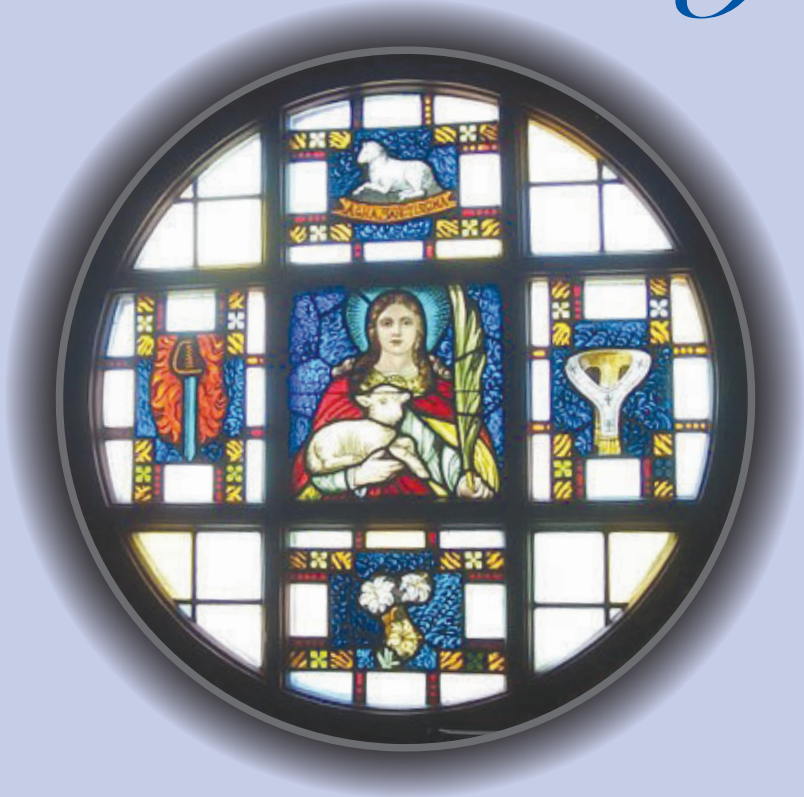

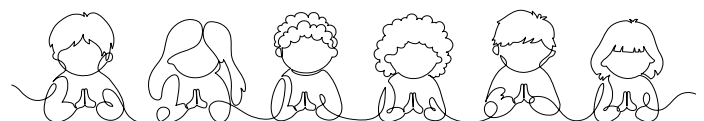
Blanket Sunday
