Tuition and Payments

- Registration Fee - \$30 individual or \$45 family (non-refundable).
- The studio calendar and tuition rate is designed to give 32 classes over a nine-month period from September to the end of May. There will be 9 equal payments by automatic withdrawal from a Visa or Mastercard with 2 installments due by September 1st. There is a two month minimal financial commitment.
- December is the costume payment only, no tuition payment.
- All payments are processed the 1st business day of each month. A late fee of \$25 will be applied to all accounts not current by the 15th of the month.
- There will be no refunds on classes or costumes. A Studio credits will be applied and is valid for one year.
- If you choose not to have a credit card on file, there will be a manual processing fee of \$5 per month on your tuition.
- 24/7 proudly offers a 10% active military discount with valid Military ID.
- Withdrawal forms must be filled out 30 days prior to stopping lessons to avoid automatic tuition payment. There is a 2 month minimum on all classes.
- In the event that the studio has to go to live Zoom or Virtual classes for the safety of students, there will be no discount on tuition and each participant takes the classes at their own risk.

The yearly tuition is divided into 9 equal payments. The schedule is as follows:

Payment #1 is due at registration and covers tuition for the month of December.

Payment #2 is due September 1st and covers September tuition.

Payment #3 is due October 1st and covers October tuition.

Payment #4 is due November 1st and covers November tuition.

December is payment for costumes that are in June Recital. Due December 1st.

Payment #5 is due January 1st and covers January tuition.

Payment #6 is due February 1st and covers February tuition.

Payment #7 is due March 1st and covers March tuition.

Payment #8 is due April 1st and covers April tuition.

Payment #9 is due May 1st and covers May tuition.

Cancellation Policy

Classes:

- 30+ day notice of cancellation: 100% credit on account for tuition paid minus \$25 cancellation fee.
- Cancellation within 2-4 weeks prior to class beginning: 50% credit on account for tuition paid minus \$25 cancellation fee.
- Less than 2 weeks of Class Cancellation Notification = No credit given.

Camps:

- 30+ day notice of cancellation: 100% credit on account for tuition paid minus \$50 cancellation fee.
- Cancellation within 2-4 weeks prior to camp beginning: 50% credit on account for tuition paid minus \$50 cancellation fee.
- Less than 2 weeks of Camp Cancellation Notification = No credit given.



Attendance Policies

There is no discount or refund for missed classes. If your child is sick, please keep them home. Make-up classes are available September through January 31, 2026. Starting in February, make up classes will be discontinued as classes will be working on recital pieces. Students may make-up 3 absences per class.



When a student misses class, it really retracts from the sequential learning that happens week after week. When they return to class, they may feel behind, which affects their confidence and performance. Strive to have your child attend every week (unless they are sick) as it ensures that the student gets a progression of learning that best leads to overall growth.

Students participating in other sports or activities should continue their training to maintain strength, stay on track with their progress, and avoid falling behind in their lessons. From September through January, students should not miss more than three consecutive classes.

Students may not miss more than 3 classes after February 1 or they may forfeit their recital participation.

Studio Policies

- All classes are based on 32 weeks. Most classes actually meet 33-34 weeks in the year, with extra weeks built in to account for potential snow days. If we are forced to close due to inclement weather or an emergency, we will only make up classes that have fallen under the 32 week minimum. We do not follow the FCPS school schedule.
- For studio closures, we notify you through email, website and social media.
- The studio is not responsible for injuries sustained in class, on premises, or at any related events.
- Dancers age 7 and under must have one parent or responsible adult present in the 24/7 lobby or in the parking lot during class time.
- The Studio is not responsible for lost or misplaced articles. Please put names on all belongings and leave expensive items at home.
- Any student with an overdue balance of more than 60 days will not be allowed to continue class until payment in full is received or payment arrangements have been made.
- Costume orders can only be picked up once the account is paid with no balance remaining.
- Upon registration, the studio is granted permission and copyrights for photos/video taken at 24/7 and may be used for social media.
- Hand sanitizer is available in each studio, in the bathrooms and at the front desk and lobby area. We encourage everyone to use it frequently.
- We encourage all students to use the bathroom before coming to the studio.

Studio Culture

- Here at 24/7 Dance Studio, we pride ourselves on offering the highest quality Dance Education to our students. Testimonials prove that our families appreciate the cleanliness of our studio, customer service, curated programming, enriching curriculum, scholarship offerings, and qualified staff. We strive to foster passion, resilience and a growth mindset through positive reinforcement. We are honored that you've chosen to be a part of our dance family.

Class Placement

- Upon registration, class placement is determined by age, skill set, and & level of previous training.
- 24/7 provides a bi-annual progress report to track a student's individual participation and technical progression throughout the season.
- At the end of the dance year, class placement for the following dance year will be based on class participation, attendance, progress, attentiveness, ability, attitude, consistency and mastery of the syllabus.
- All placement decisions are made by the Director and the instructors based on the best interest of each individual student.
- Students of the same age and years of experience may have completely different capabilities. Students will have the most successful experience in their technical training by being placed in their individually best fit level.
- Dance levels are different from grades at school. In most cases, our children's dance classes are based on a one year program. Our programming for Youth through Teen classes is typically a 2 year program per level.



Classroom/Studio Etiquette

- Proper classroom etiquette is a very important part of the learning process. Always show respect to the instructor and always come prepared for class with proper attire and shoes with hair pulled back.
- Students are expected to be in class every week. Our curriculum builds upon itself and we don't want any student to fall behind. Consistency is the key to success!
- Be on time. Late arrivals not only disrupt the class, but cause the late student to miss important warm up exercises. If a student is late or needs to leave before class is over, please inform the front desk ahead of time.
- No gum chewing, eating, or drinking is allowed in the studios or dressing rooms. Water bottles without straws are welcome. No cell phones out during class and absolutely no cell phone use in the dressing rooms!
- Only water is permitted in the lobby/classrooms.
- Be appreciative of corrections given by your instructors and work hard to apply them each week. A correction should be viewed as a compliment from your instructor. It means they see your potential and believe in your abilities. If you ever receive a correction that's confusing, never hesitate to ask for clarification. Applying corrections is the path towards growth!
- Be kind to your classmates. Displays of disrespect or bullying are unacceptable and will be addressed.
- When class is finished, make sure to thank your instructor.
- Upon entering 24/7 Dance Studio, a positive and professional attitude is expected by all students, family members and staff.
- Profanity, gossip, and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated at 24/7 Dance Studio.
- Please use the restroom before class.
- Use the dressing room or cubbies for dance bags and belongings.
- Please drop off students early enough to get ready for class and pick up children ON TIME.
- Only ONE parent may enter to escort kids 7 and younger to their class and may stay in the lobby to observe their performer (no siblings). Spot TV is available for free to all families.
- NO smoking or vaping in or outside of the building.
- When students are absent it affects the entire class and group choreography. Students are responsible for knowing the missed material by consulting a classmate or scheduling a private lesson.
- Students may be asked to observe class if they arrive more than 10 minutes late and have missed warming up which is essential to the safety of the student.

- All updates and important information will be sent through our monthly newsletter. We also encourage you to follow us on Facebook and Instagram.
- Your child should be in an environment where they feel comfortable, special, and cared for. At 24/7 Dance Studio, our staff is trained in making sure they teach, use and instill Self-Confidence, Teamwork, Kindness, Technique and Respect.
- 24/7 Dance Studio staff have extensive training through studio, college, certifications; and many have worked professionally in the industry. We offer and encourage our staff further training each and every year. Check out our staff bios on our website. 24/7 Dance Studio boasts 5 beautiful studios, each with professional dance flooring. 3 of our rooms have marley dance floors and we have 2 rooms with floating wood floors.
- If a child is injured, parents are notified and staff will follow up with the family the next day.
- All 24/7 staff are CPR and First Aid Certified.

Parent Portal

24/7 is proud to offer an online solution for parents and account holders to access all of their account information in the Parent Portal. This service allows users to process payments for charges, enter and modify contact information, access event information and register for select classes from the comfort of their home 24 hours a day.

Our annual Dance Recital is will be held June 4, 5, and 6 at the beautiful Weinberg Center. Preparing for this production is part of the student's dance education; however, the student is not obligated to participate. To ensure participation, students will be required to attend classes regularly, attend rehearsals associated with the recital, and pay for any costume(s) needed for their class.
