

Thank you from Fr. Devine...

Our second seminarian, Patrick Earley, will be finishing his six-week assignment this weekend. This was Pat's first experience living and working in a parish assignment. Pat "shadowed" Fr. Rodrigo and me throughout the many pastoral visits and appointments. Pat experienced all aspects of parish life, from an emergency call at the hospital, Masses at the prison and state hospital, assisting at parish Masses, baptisms, anointings, and marriages, to leading Monday and Wednesday night discussions for adults and young adults around the fire pits. Additionally, our staff instructed him in administrative, financial, educational and maintenance responsibilities. Pat didn't have much free time.

Although he'll be returning to the seminary with a focus on academic learning, he'll return to our parish for 4 hours a week to continue his pastoral training. May this summer's experience help him in discerning the Lord's call to priesthood and may his witness of faith encourage us and give us hope for the future of the Church.

This is one of the best running "machines" in the archdiocese if I were to guess due to the talented staff that works tirelessly and the initiative of so many parishioners.

I had so much fun joining the youth group at Catholic Heart Workcamp last month, kickstarting the young adult group, and spending a few nights around the fire with the Faith on Fire group. Fr. Bill, Fr. Rodrigo, Sean and I built a great friendship in the rectory (over many glasses of whole milk). Truly you all are a gift on my path, and I pray for you each day and will continue to do so in my journey.
