NEED A HELPING HAND?

Our *Inspire Youth Group* just returned from a powerful week serving in some of the poorest communities in our country through a mission trip to Niagara Falls. These teens have worked on homes, cleaned up neighborhoods, and spent time with those in need, and now they're looking to continue that mission right here at home. We're looking for local service projects where we can lend a helping hand. If you or someone you know could use help with a small project, like tidying a yard, organizing a garage, or doing light home tasks, we'd love to help. These projects typically take about 2½ hours and are meant to bless those who could use a little extra support right now, such as seniors, young families, or anyone facing challenges. A team of two adults and 4-5 teens will be assigned to each project We will visit a week or two before your scheduled project to assess the site and confirm details.

- We do **not** paint or do construction.
- We are **not** able to remove trash or yard waste. We provide the bags; you provide the removal.
- Be ready to share on your application what tools or supplies you already have (e.g., rakes, lawnmower, hedge clippers) and what we need to bring.


