LAST WEEK'S PARISH REGISTRATION AND VOLUNTEER SIGN-UPS

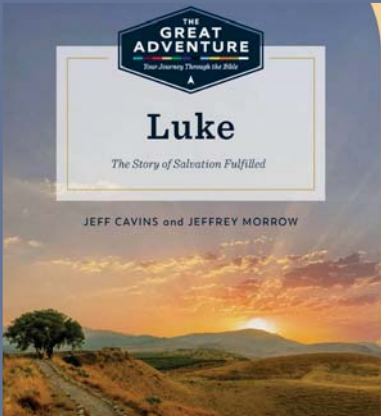

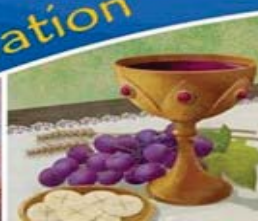

STEP TWO

Talk to ministry heads if you have questions.

STEP THREE

Complete your CORI form and Volunteer form at the designated tables.

STEP FOUR

Return forms to a staff member at the check-in table. A staff member will **verify your license for your CORI**.

STEP FIVE

Sign up for VIRTUS training if you haven't completed it.

STEP SIX

Visit our parish registration tent to register with our parish or update your information if necessary.

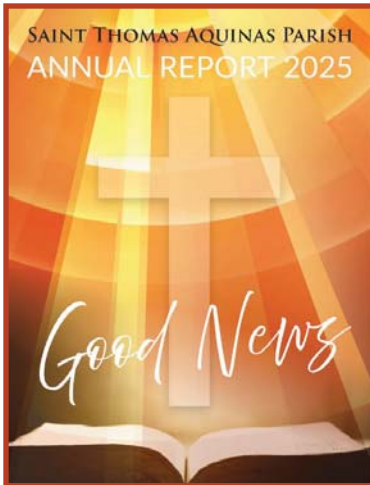

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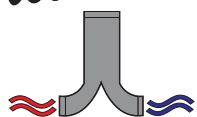
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
