Thank you for the positive comments to last's week's **Annual Appeal** homilies. If you did not receive a letter this past week asking for your support, please take a letter, pledge card, and envelope located at the church/chapel exits. Thank you for understanding the need and being willing to make a contribution.

As you can see from this bulletin, **there's a lot going on in our parish** and I encourage you to consider engaging in one or more of our activities or ministries.

All those who've volunteered for a ministry should hear from your ministry's leader by this **Wednesday, Oct 15**. Many of the ministries, i.e. ushers, lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, and altar servers, will require specific training. We'll put the dates of these trainings in the bulletin in the upcoming weeks. Please arrange your schedule so you can attend your ministry's mandatory training.

We do have a need for additional **Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist (EMHC)** so that we can provide our parishioners the opportunity to receive the Lord's Precious Blood at additional Masses. In order to do this, **we need 5 EMHC at every Mass**.

Note: Hopefully, if many volunteer, you'll only be assigned to assist twice a month. While we'll try to assign you to your Mass of preference, we ask that you be flexible to occasionally assist at another Mass time.
