Lauren Pimentel, Theology teacher at Bishop Stang presented on Divine Revelation, God revealing Himself to us. We can know God through faith and reason, or intellect. Our patron saint, St. Thomas Aquinas, gives us **Five Proofs for the existence of God.**

- Whatever is in motion is put in motion by a first mover. *This First Mover is God.*
- Everything that exists was caused to exist by something else. *This First Cause is God.*
- There must exist a necessary being who is not dependent on anything else for its existence. *This Necessary Being is God.*
- In order to have degrees of perfection, a perfect being must exist to whom you can compare being, goodness, truth, and dignity. *This Perfect Being is God.*
- Nature shows order and intricacy. It must have an intelligent designer. *The Intelligent Designer is God.*
