

As you can see from this barometer, many have already made a contribution to our Annual Appeal and for that I'm very grateful.

A month ago, Fr. Rodrigo and I shared the need that we have to balance our budget. Our parish is growing and expanding the number of ministries in order to meet the needs of our parishioners. Because of this, our operating costs exceed \$1,000,000 and we are totally dependent on your financial support. While parishioners are very generous in their weekly/ monthly financial contributions and gifts, we still run a significant deficit. We need the funds from this Appeal in order to help balance our budget and so I'm asking for your help.

I'm very grateful that 164 persons have increased their donation from last year and 26 are new donors. While this is encouraging, I'm hoping that those who have not yet contributed might be willing to make a donation this year.


