A Note from Fr. Devine...

Week of Christian Unity

Very often, the “Week of Christian Unity,” January 18-25, gets ignored because of all the other celebrations and events on our parish calendar.

1,700 years ago, the division in the Christian Church was acknowledged and led to a common profession of faith, the Nicene Creed. For many years following, there was a unity of belief, however, in time and for different reasons, many left the Catholic Christian Church.

Today, there are 45,000 Christian denominations. One of the last things Jesus prayed for was unity.... “I pray not only for my disciples, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I, in you...that they may be one as we are one. (Jn 51:64-22).



The Graymoor Ecumenical and Interreligious Institute in Garrison, NY has published the following text about the Christian Week of Unity. The Graymoor Friars continue to serve at the Chapel of our Savior, Westgate Mall, Brockton.

The theme for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2026 is taken from Ephesians 4:4, “There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling.” These words of St. Paul see the unity of the community of believers as a vocation, a calling by the Holy Spirit. This requires conversion of heart, which is not possible without openness to reconciliation. This unity is linked to one hope and practiced in communal support, by embracing diversity while maintaining communion. This also means accepting the diversity of gifts exercised in ministry, the goal of which is building up unity for the whole. “And he gave some as apostles, others as prophets, others as evangelists, others as pastors and teachers, to equip the holy ones for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ” (4:11-12). This unity is guided by a mutual search for truth in a spirit of communal love. “Rather, living the truth in love, we should grow in every way into him who is the head, Christ, from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, with the proper functioning of each part, brings about the body’s growth and builds itself up in love.” (4:15-16) It is in Ephesians 4 that Paul emphasizes the seven “unities” of the Church: Spirit, hope; one Lord, faith, and baptism; and the one God (4:4-6).




