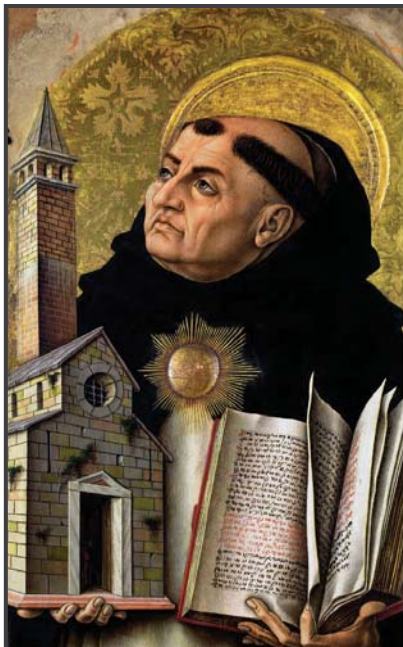

## FEAST OF ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

### JANUARY 28, 2026

This weekend, we celebrate the feast day of our parish's namesake, Saint Thomas Aquinas, recognized on January 28. Born in Sicily in 1225, St. Thomas became a Dominican priest against his family's wishes. He studied in Cologne, France, under St. Albert the Great and is considered the patron saint of students and universities due to his numerous scholarly theological writings. St. Thomas also composed the text to five hymns still in use today. Eucharistic in nature, these hymns were inspired by a miracle St. Thomas witnessed in which a consecrated host shed blood. When Pope Urban IV instituted the feast of Corpus Christi in 1264 in response to this miracle, he commissioned St. Thomas Aquinas to compose these hymns. These are Adoro Te Devote (370), Pange Lingua (page 103), Panis Angelicus (373), Tantum Ergo Sacramentum (page 103), and O Salutaris Hostia (677). In honor of St. Thomas, we will incorporate some of his hymns at Mass this weekend. Translations of his poetry can be found in the Breaking Bread missal (see the numbers presented above).

### MARRIAGE

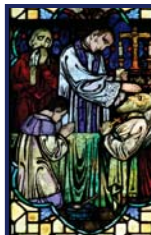
To be married in our parish, call the office at least 8 months in advance. **Marriage Preparation instruction required.**
