## FEEDBACK FROM THE “FAMILY & FRIENDS OF A LGBTQ PERSON” MEETINGS

Since last January 2025, family and friends of LTBGQ persons met regularly in a supportive space to share personal experiences and stories involving our friends or family members who identify as being part of the LGBTQ community. We discussed and reflected on the Gospel, and reviewed the Catholic Church teachings. These consistently provide a moral framework for building a just society based on the belief in the sacredness of all human life and the inherent dignity of the human person. We also discussed the importance of developing a safer and more welcoming parish environment for LGBTQ persons. Following are responses from some group participants:

- *The 3 pillars, **respect, compassion and sensitivity**, that support the bridge to LGBTQ ministry are not really different than how we practice ministry to any group of people.*
- *We are all part of the Body of Christ. We should move beyond personal prejudices to see Christ in one another, treating our LGBTQ brothers and sisters with dignity and empathy, avoiding the use of demeaning language or unjust discrimination.*
- *By virtue of their Baptism in the Catholic Church, the LGBTQ Catholic's place in the church is sealed. They are as much full members of the church as any other Catholic.*
- *My child was glad to learn that our parish had a group that wanted to recognize LGBTQ persons and that the church itself welcomes them. She wants to be recognized as a person, not as someone who “needs to be fixed.”*
- *I have a deeper and clearer understanding of the Catholic Church's position. We are all children of God, wonderfully made and unconditionally loved by God. Getting to know and understand each other is critical. Be kind to one another and do not judge.*
- *My take away from this wonderful group and learning about the LGBTQ+ community and the Catholic Church is that love, forgiveness, and understanding should be met equally.*


