

Due to safe environment reasons put in place by the USCCB to protect minors, Hallow is only available for those 18 years old and older to download. Parents may participate in the Kid's Lenten Challenge with their children.

2. Join the parish page.

  - Select "Join a Church."
  - Search for Saint Thomas Aquinas, Bridgewater.


## LENTEN CALENDARS

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has created a Lenten calendar for you to use with your family as you go through your Lenten journey. They are available at the entrances of the church and chapel. Lent is a 40-day season of **prayer**, **fasting**, and **almsgiving** that began on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday.

## ABSTINENCE

**Fridays of Lent** are days of abstinence. **ABSTINENCE** is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning abstinence, please consult Fr. Devine or Fr. Rodrigo.

## Msgr. Paul Garrity



Monsignor Garrity grew up in Somerville, MA and was ordained by Cardinal Medeiros in 1973. He has served as Parochial Vicar in parishes in Billerica and East Boston, as well as the Pastor for 18 years at St. Mary's in Lynn, where he was instrumental in developing St. Mary's Catholic High School. Additionally, he was Pastor at St. Catherine's in Norwood, and Pastor at St. Brigid's & Sacred Heart in Lexington. Monsignor also served as Campus Minister at UMass Lowell and early in his priesthood was elected President of the Priests Senate of the Archdiocese by his brother priests. During his 52 years as a priest, Monsignor Garrity served as a member of the State Board of Education and Trustee of Regis College in Weston. He currently celebrates Mass at St. Raphael Parish in Medford. He also writes a regular opinion column for the Lynn Item on the North Shore.


