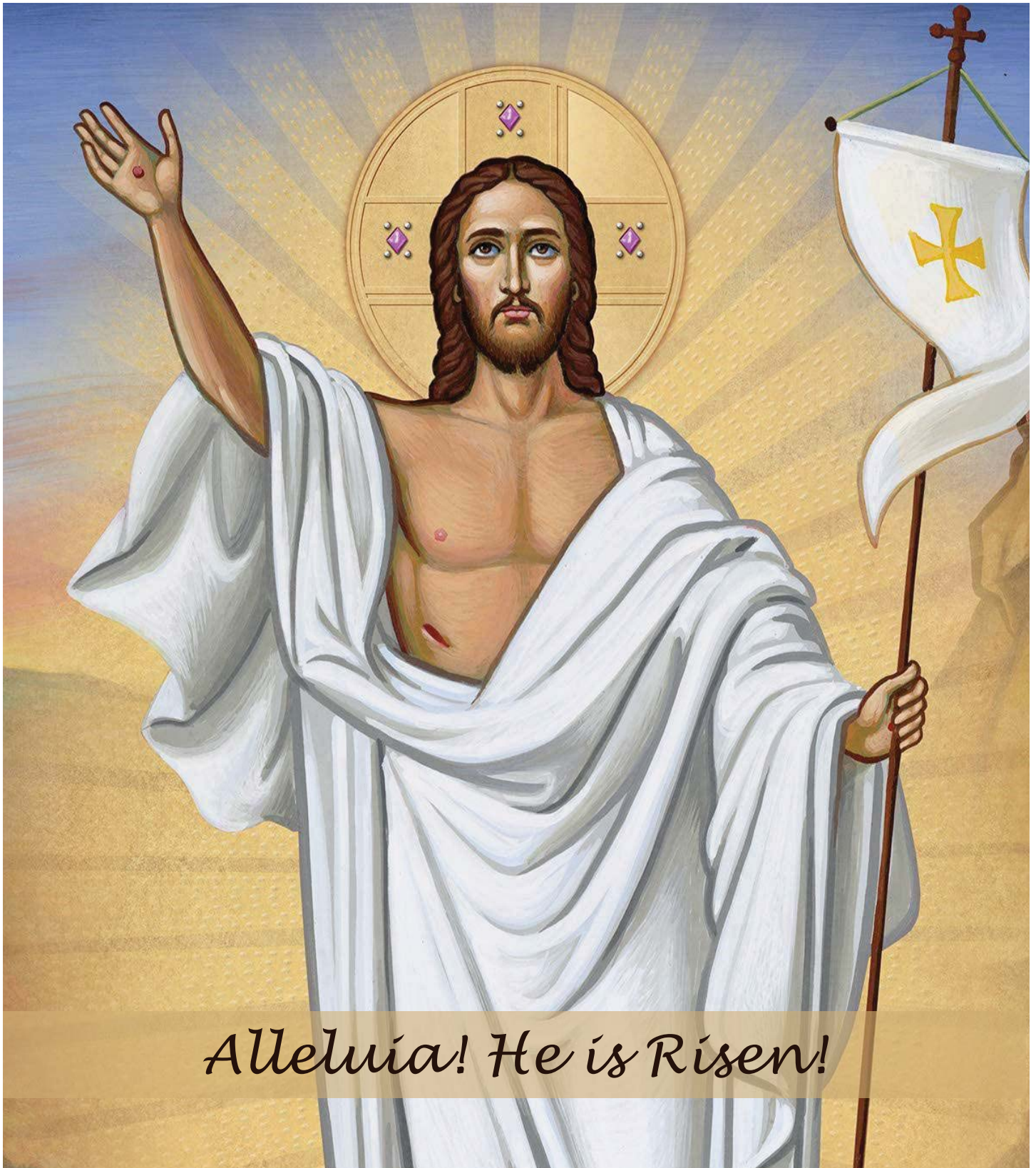
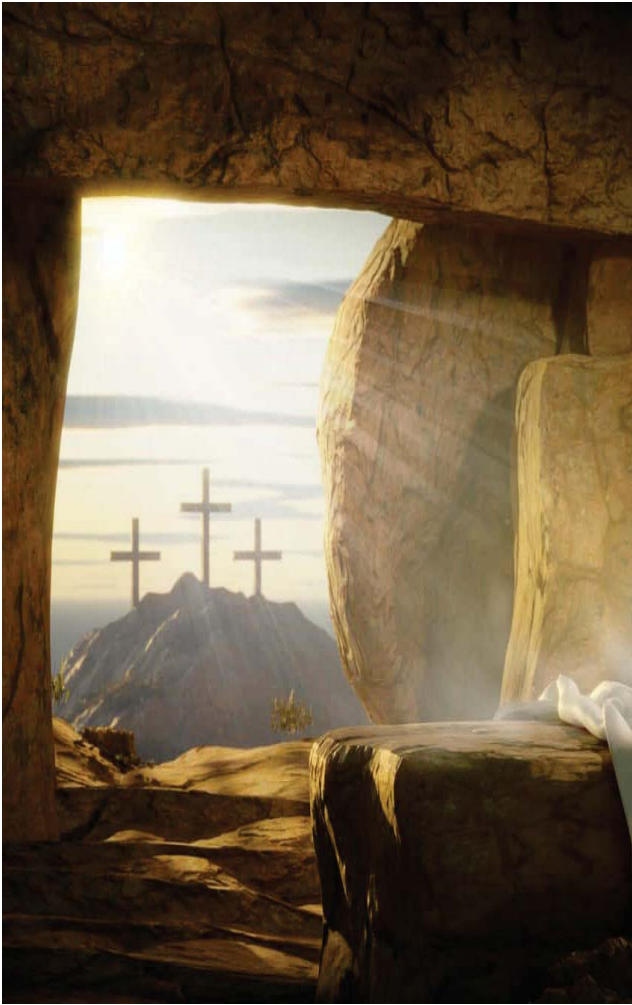

Alleluia! He is Risen!

If ever there was a reason to celebrate Easter and all that it signifies, it is this year.

Look around our world today. We see wars that seem to have no end in sight. Innocent people are being killed indiscriminately. The rights of citizens are threatened. There is so much division in our country and in our world. Many individuals and families face medical, financial, and emotional challenges. The list goes on and on. Many people are anxious about the present and uncertain about the future. They are searching for signs of hope that things can and will get better.

So where can we find this hope so desperately needed in today's world?

We are often led to believe that our hope for the future depends on financial security, political power, or advances in technology. Yet we have seen that these things often benefit only a few and cannot truly satisfy the deepest needs of the human heart. Instead, we must look to God's love for the world - a love that was manifested when he took on our humanity and entered our world, which we celebrated four months ago at Christmas; and a love that was manifested again when he rose from the dead, which we celebrate this Easter day. God will never abandon us.

Easter is not simply the remembrance of something that happened long ago. Easter is a declaration that Jesus Christ is alive now. By rising from the dead, Jesus demonstrated his power not only over death, but also over sin and evil. Through the grace he offers us freely, he helps us face the challenges of our lives and of our world with confidence and hope.

Because of Easter, we believe that love is stronger than hatred, forgiveness is stronger than resentment, respect is stronger than division, faith is stronger than doubt, trust is stronger than fear, and life is stronger than death.

We experience this hope in a special way whenever we gather for Mass. We listen to faith-filled Scripture that reminds us of God's love in the past, his presence with us today, and his promise for the future. We also receive the Eucharist, where the risen Christ comes to us personally and strengthens us with his grace.

In addition to celebrating our faith and hope during the Easter Mass, we also experience something else - Easter joy. Just as many people set aside differences and came together at Christmas, so now what began at Christmas is fulfilled at Easter. The Child born in Bethlehem is the risen Lord who walks with us today.

Because Christ is Risen, we are never without hope. Because Christ is Risen, we are never alone. Because Christ is Risen, we are called to bring that hope to others - in our families, in our communities, and in our world.

This is the meaning of Easter. This is the source of our hope. And this is the joy we celebrate today.

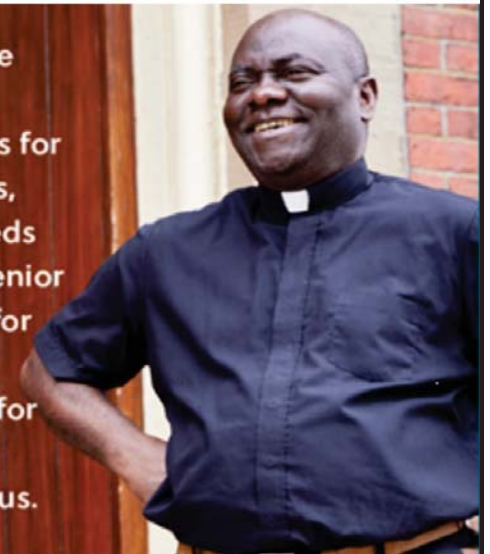

FAITH FORMATION UPDATE

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PARENT NIGHT

First Holy Communion parent nights provide an opportunity for Fr. Bill to offer encouragement and pastoral guidance to support their children’s faith formation. Fr. Bill explained that the miracle of the Eucharist has its roots in the Old Testament. It was instituted on Holy Thursday, the sacrifice of the Lamb of God (instead of a Passover lamb) happens on Good Friday, and Easter Sunday confirms the New Covenant. This living relationship with Christ is renewed each time we celebrate the Mass. He emphasized the importance of weekly attendance, reminding parents that we encounter Jesus in the Eucharist, and the more we receive Him, the more we become like Him. Weekly Mass strengthens our faith. He also noted that Extraordinary Ministers are available to bring Holy Communion to those who are homebound.

Parents shared several key takeaways, including, “Our Catholic faith has roots in the Old Testament,” “Faith formation should continue beyond second grade,” “You are what you eat,” and “The Mass represents Jesus’ sacrifice on Calvary.” *May your worthy reception of Holy Communion lead you closer to heaven!* - Debbie Hill, Director

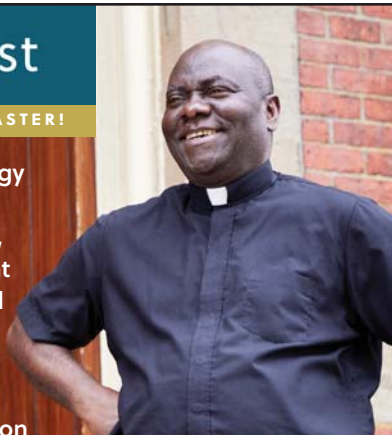
