Nicene Creed

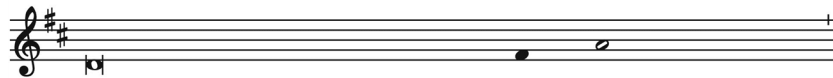

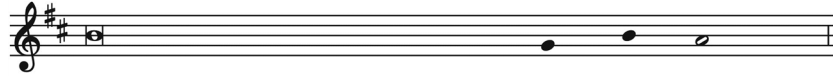

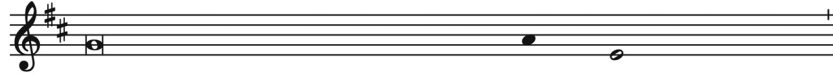
