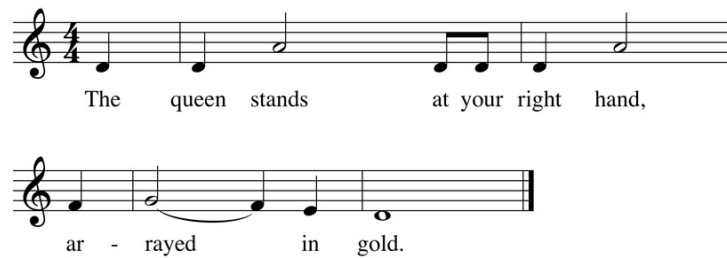

The English translation of the Psalm Response from the *Lectionary for Mass*

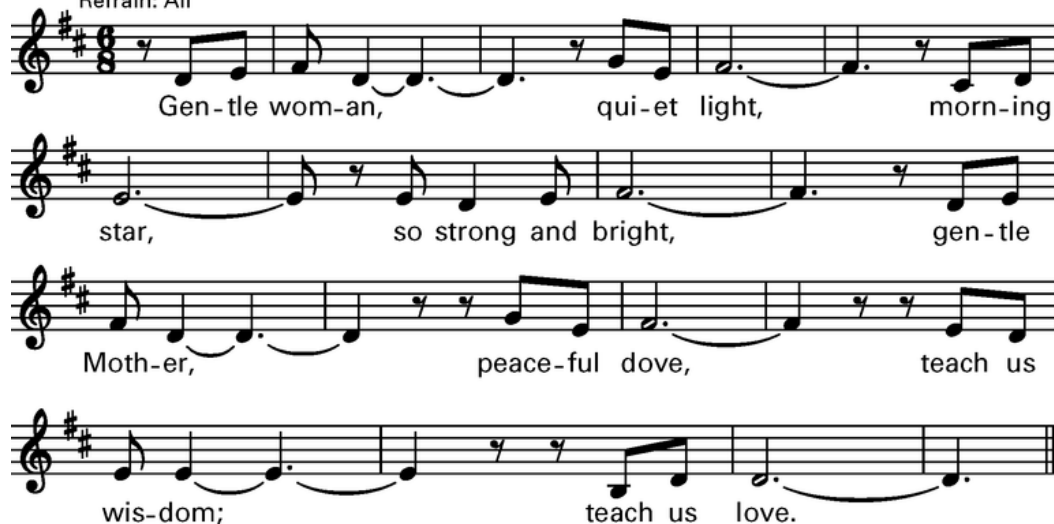
