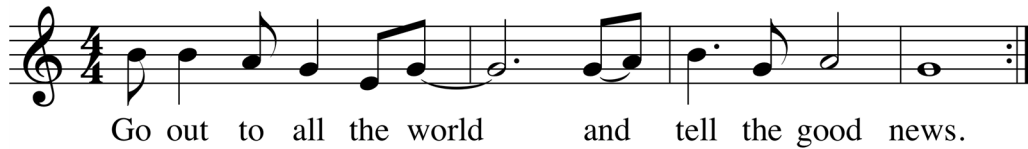

Nicene Creed

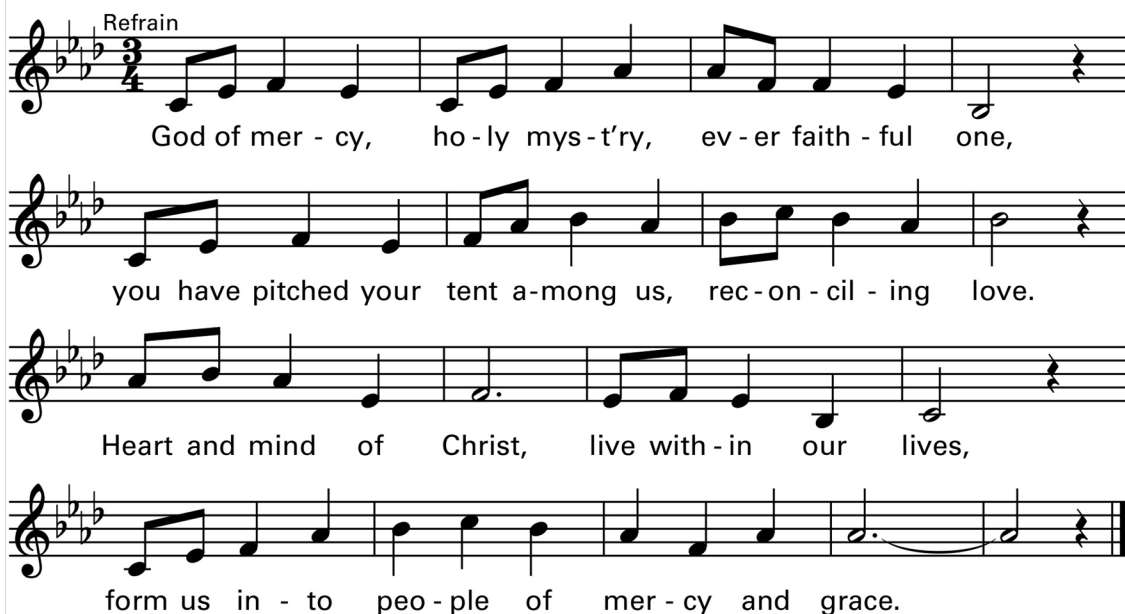
