FLY LIKE A BIRD

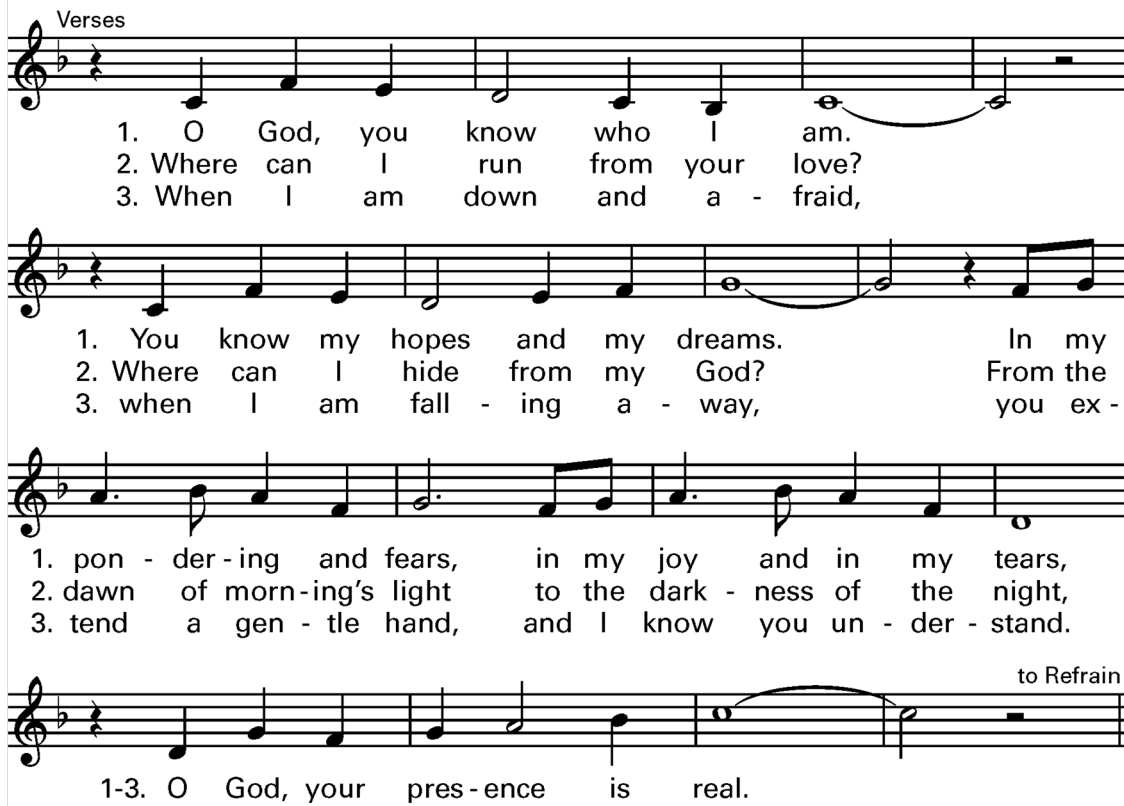

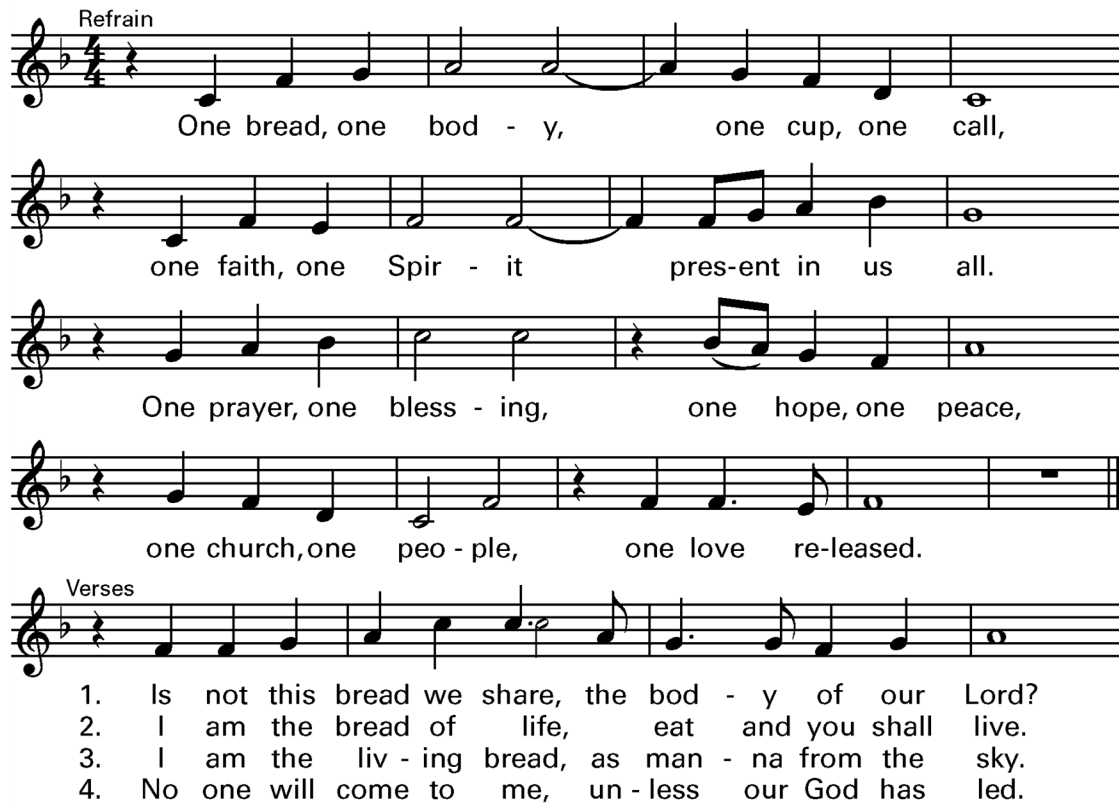
