## Our Mission Statement

The mission of Walnut Street Center is to empower adults with Intellectual Disabilities to live engaged and meaningful lives.

The agency accomplishes this by offering a variety of person-centered support services that provide the opportunity to live, work, volunteer and socialize within the community.

Support services reflect personal choice, preference and need. Walnut Street Center continues to develop and change services to meet the evolving needs of the people we serve.

## WSC

Walnut Street Center Inc. is a non-profit human services agency that provides comprehensive support to adults with Intellectual Disabilities. The center was founded in 1970 by a community of parents seeking services for their own children, and has grown to include 24-Hour Residential, Individual Supports (less than 24-hour residential), Community-Based Day Support and Day Habilitation. WSC serves more than 150 people annually.

In addition to its long-standing service area of Somerville, Cambridge, Arlington, in 2017, the center has grown to include the Greater Boston and Metro North service areas.
