MINUTES of a Special Meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Pleasantville Fire District held on April 9, 2026 during a recess in the Annual Meeting of the Pleasantville Volunteer Fire Department in the Meeting Room, Pleasantville Fire Headquarters, 75 Washington Avenue, Pleasantville, New York pursuant to prior notice.

Attending: Commissioners M. Rufino, J.M. Cullen, M. Colmenares, C. Onuma and T. Trudo. Secretary-Treasurer T. Langan. Members of the Chief's Staff and numerous department members also attended.

The Chairman stated that the reason for the meeting was to consider and act upon the nominations for Department Line Officers made at the Annual Meeting of the Pleasantville Volunteer Fire Department held this evening.

The Secretary reported that the Department had nominated the following individuals for office: Chief Martineau to be Chief of the Department; Assistant Chief Scopino to be Assistant Chief, Captain Stephane Zapletal to be Captain and Matthew Colmenares to be 1st Lieutenant.

The Chairman inquired of the Board's approval or disapproval of the nominations.

On a motion by Commissioner Cullen, seconded by Commissioner Colmenares, and unanimously carried, each of the nominees was appointed to the office for which he had been nominated, in each case until his respective successor is nominated, appointed, installed and sworn into office.

Badges were presented as follows: Ex-Captain A.J. Greco presented the Chief's badge to Chief Martineau. Ex-Chief Perino presented the Assistant Chief's badge to Assistant Chief Scopino. Commissioner Cullen presented the Captain's badge to Captain Zapletal. Commissioner Colmenares presented the 1st Lieutenant's badge to his son, Lieutenant Colmenares.

The Secretary then administered the following Oath of Office to the Department Line Officers, as follows:

The Chairman thanked all present for coming to the meeting.

There being no further business, and on a motion by Commissioner Cullen, seconded by Commissioner Onuma, and unanimously carried, the meeting was adjourned and the Annual Department Meeting resumed.
