## **OPENING THE CANTEEN,**

You enter the building through the main entrance on the right side of the canteen and you can use the tag to open the connecting door to the canteen. Put the door on the hook.

This connecting door must always remain open until the canteen is closed.

### **Light on:**

The 3 light buttons for the canteen and terrace are on the right side of the bar against the wall. There is also a light above the bar, the controls are on the wall, to the left of the coffee machine. Press on, swipe your finger over the lines for more or less light.

### **Hygiene:**

Check that everything is tidy behind the bar and in the kitchen, clean up any mess. Make a note of this in the logbook. Check the changing rooms and toilets to see if they have been cleaned properly and see if there is enough toilet paper. There is toilet paper in the cupboard.

Empty the trash cans if necessary.

### **Turn on:**

Cash register, coffee machine and TV (see instruction).

Fill the beer sink with water and a drop of glass cleaner. Fill the container with beer skimmers with water. Only switch on the dishwasher when there are enough dishes to wash. Only turn on the deep fryer if necessary (approx. 8 min. warm-up time)

### **Stock:**

Check whether the refrigerators behind the bar are sufficiently stocked with cold drinks, if necessary, top up from the storage room/refrigerator.

### **Telephone + Tennis Courts lights:**

Check whether the mobile phone is in the white drawer by the coffee machine.

Check if the phone is on the charger. Enable: use pin code 1982.

Switching the Tennis courts lighting on and off is done by telephone (see Tennis courts lighting instructions page 27 en 28 )

### **Doors:**

You can open the sliding doors to the terrace depending on the weather.

The sliding doors can be opened and closed with the rotary knob. Push the door handle and turn the knob at the same time.

Keep the doors closed if it's too hot or cold outside, the room temperature is controlled automatically.

### **Keys:**

The key for the cleaning cabinet and meter cabinet (in the hallway) is in the middle black drawer behind the bar. Here is also the Allen key for the disabled toilet.

**DO NOT SELL ALCHOL TO MINORS (<18).  
WHEN IN DOUBT ABOUT THE AGE, ALWAYS ASK FOR ID!  
No ID = no alcohol sales!**

## **Closing the Canteen.**

The canteen closes at 22:30 on working days and at 16:30 hour on weekends.

### **Cleaning before closing:**

#### **Start half an hour before closing time with:**

Flushing the coffee machine (see instructions) Cleaning the beer tap section (see instructions)  
Switching off and cleaning the deep fryer (see instructions). Switch off the extractor hood (see instructions).

Empty the rinse machine and then switch it off (see instructions).

Replenish stocks.

Put everything you used back in the same place!

Wipe tables and bar with cleaning cloths.

Check rubbish bins, also in the toilets, empty them if necessary and replace the rubbish bag

Check all areas and clear away any loose clutter.

Sweep the floor in the cafeteria, behind the bar and in the kitchen.

Turn off the cash register and clean the screen.

Turn off all lights in the canteen and switch off the Tennis Courts lighting if necessary.

The Tennis Courts lighting switches off automatically at 23:00 hour.

You leave the canteen through the connecting door. Close the intermediate door properly.

You leave the building through the main entrance.

Alarm turns on automatically at midnight.

#### **Check that all doors are closed:**

Lock the sliding doors to the terrace, push the door handle and turn the knob at the same time.  
Check whether the outer door of the cask storage room and the emergency exit in the corridor are locked.

**The alarm activates automatically at midnight.**

**The alarm will not turn on if any door is unlocked.**

**Therefore, always check that all doors are locked.**

## **Where can everything be found?**

### **Bar :**

#### **Under the bar:**

Beer kegs in the refrigerator, carbon dioxide keg, first aid kits, trays and music system.

#### **Refrigerators:**

Soft drinks, special beer, 0% beer, white wine, Rosé in the fridge end red wine on the desk.

#### **Black drawers:**

Are filled with cutlery and other bar accessories. In the middle black drawer are all the keys.

#### **White drawers:**

The telephone, TV and radio remote control is located in the white drawer by the coffee machine.

The manual and logbook are in the white drawer next to the sink.

#### **White cabinets:**

All coffee accessories are in the white cupboard near the coffee machine. In the other white cupboards, you will find beer cleaner, tea towels for glassware, coasters and extra glasses.

### **Kitchen:**

The hanging cupboard contains crockery for nuts, sandwiches, snacks and sauce trays. Below is the sink for hand washing.

Baking utensils hang on the wall and are under the baking tray. Instruction for snack dish, portions, etc. hangs above the serving hatch. One fridge with cheese/ sausage/ sauces etc. + supply of cold drinks.

One freezer with all snacks/fries etc. + cold packs.

#### **Packaging storage space:**

One freezer with all bread / sandwiches.

Stock kegs / laundry basket / aprons / bag for empty plastic bottles / tin balls for sale.

#### **Stock space:**

All food + non-food.

#### **Tool cabinet:**

In the hallway next to men's dressing room for cleaning products, toilet rolls. Key is in the middle black drawer behind the bar.

#### **Waste container outside:**

For garbage bags, there is a big waste container behind lane 3.

Garbage bags are on the shelf in the kitchen.

Glassware simply goes in the garbage bag; the waste company sorts it.

## Sale of drinks and food,

### Please note:

**No alcohol sales under the age of 18!!!!**  
**Always ask for identification when in doubt about the age limit,**  
**No ID means no alcohol sales!**

### Hygiene is very important!

So always remember to wash your hand often!

### **Debit card only, no cash payment, or put the consumptions on a receipt.**

Basically, refreshments are paid for with a debit card.

However, if someone would like a receipt, create one on the cash register (see page 10).

Paper receipts are also possible, but they must always include the name and date.

Receipts must be settled on the same day.

In principle, consumptions are paid immediately. But if someone prefers a receipt: write down the full name + date and repeat the consumptions on the receipt.

### Soft drinks:

The soft drinks should be mirrored in the refrigerators, the coolest drinks should be at the front and the new drinks at the back.

Pay attention to the best before date for dairy products such as Chocomel.

### Music system and TV:

CDs can be played (are in the white drawer next to it), you can search for a DAB radio station or play your own Spotify music using Bluetooth.

Turn on TV or Radio, see page 26, 27.

### Serving Tea:

The ginger and mint tea go into large Picardy glasses.

On the coffee machine, press 'hot water', then press 'hot water' again and when the glass is almost full, press cancel.

Other tea goes into the glasses with ear.

### Coffee:

Coffee, espresso and cappuccino go in regular coffee cups.

The latte macchiato goes into a medium-sized Picardy glass.

### Cleaning glassware:

Clean wine and beer glasses in the beer rinsing tank, not in the rinsing machine.

**Toss mornings and evening:**

Every Monday, Wednesday and Friday morning from 9:00 to 12:00 hour.  
And Tuesdays from 19:00 to 22:00 hour.

**Guest players, (Introduc )**

The cost for introducers is paid in advance when reserving a court.

If payment is not made in advance, a  10 fee must be paid via the "Introduc " sales button.

**Manual and Logbook:**

The manual and the logbook are in the white drawer to the right of the tap. Each bartender signs his/her name in the logbook, including the date. If someone doesn't show up, make a note of that too. Also note in the logbook if something needs to be added or replaced. Write a short reflection, so e.g. was it busy, did you like it, boring, ideas etc..

Always note technical problems with plumbing, lighting, cash register or pin.

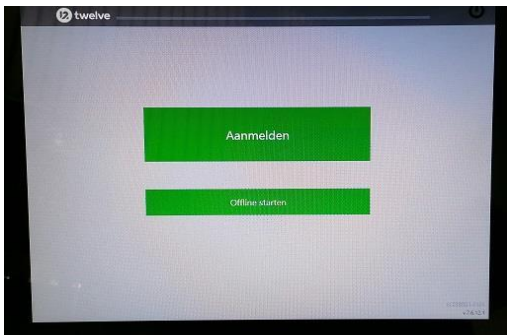

# CASH DESK and PIN (Debit card)

NO CASH! PIN ONLY!

## LOGIN (Aanmelden)



At the bottom right at the arrow is the main switch, press it when the screen is black (or touch the Standby screen).

Wait until 'Aanmelden' appears and is green. Press the 'Aanmelden' button and wait for the article screen to appear.

'Aanmelden' remains greyed out? Then press "Start Offline" (No Internet connection)

## Working with the touch screen.

First, choose an article group at the top. Then press the button of the consumption you want to hit.

### To increase consumptions (3 options):

Press the consumption several times

Press the consumption and then the +

Press on the X (so don't touch consumption yet), then on the number, then on okay, then press on the consumption.

Use the - button to select the quantity of an item to remove

Press the — button long to delete the entire order.



## PAYMENT with Pin, Tip or book away.

Touch the "PIN betaling" or "Fooi of wegboeken" button.

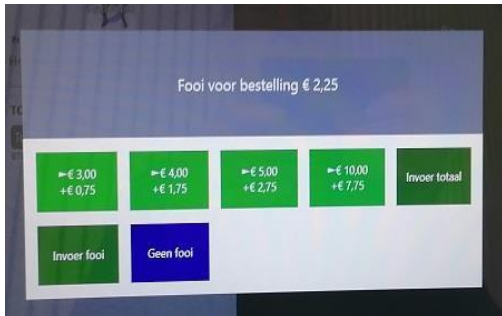
With "Pinbetaling" the amount appears directly on the pin device and can therefore be used immediately with a debit card

If the customer still wants to give a tip (Fooi), then press "Terug".

Correction or stop? Press cancel and the pin and the transaction can be done again



## PIN WITH A TIP.



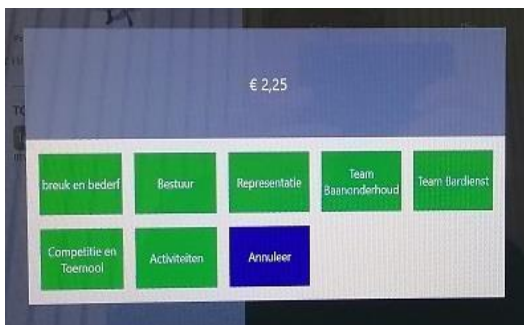
Press "Enter total".

Fill in: the total amount incl. tip (remember the comma) and then press ok.

After that you can pin.

The "Pay via ATM" screen appears and the total amount is in the ATM to PIN.

## REMOVE CONSUMPTION BY COMMITTEES OR CLUB ACTIVITIES. (WEGBOEKEN)



Bookkeeping is intended for recording own use or loss due to breakage or decay. After touching the "Booking" button, a selection screen will appear. Touch the desired activity or commission button to book the amount to the correct activity.

**The wegboek transactions are settled internally and not pinned.**

Annuleer, return to article screen.

## **Make receipts at the cash register instead of using paper receipts.**

Instead of writing down consumption on paper receipts, you can create receipts by name on the cash register and pay faster. (See page 10.)

This feature is useful when it is very busy, e.g., during competitions or events.

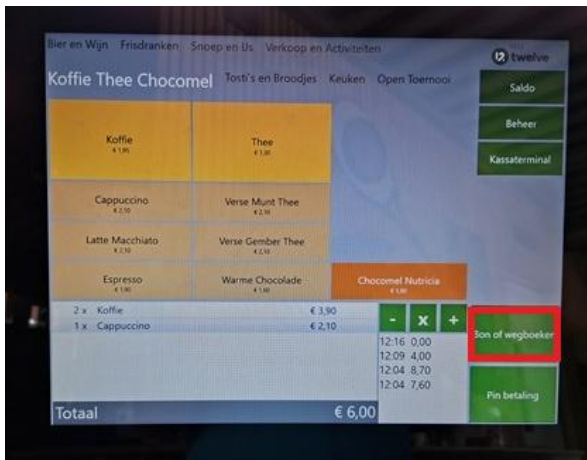
## **After the bar service :**

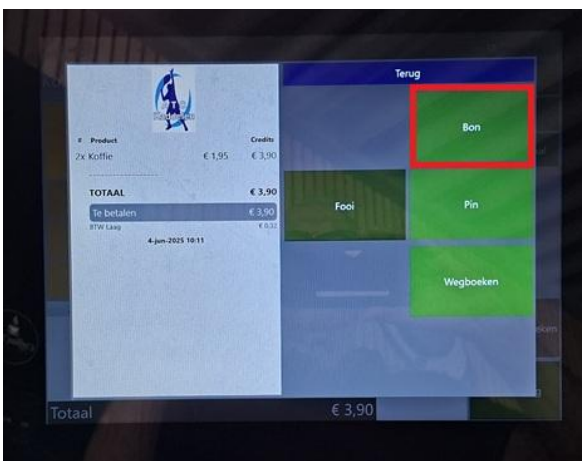
## CREATING RECEIPTS ON THE TILL.

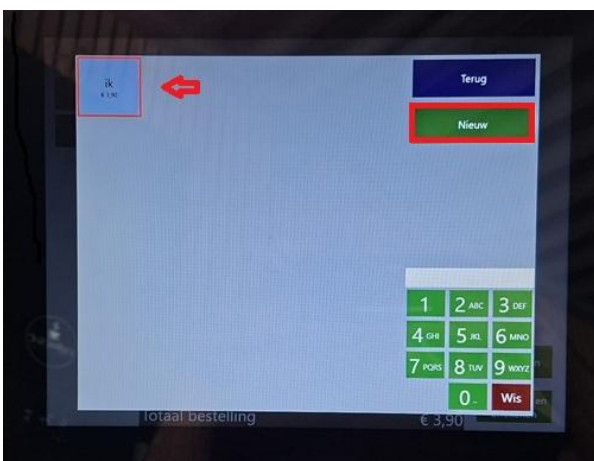

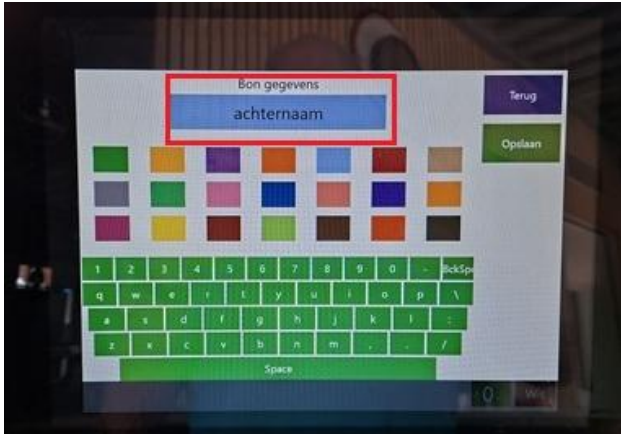

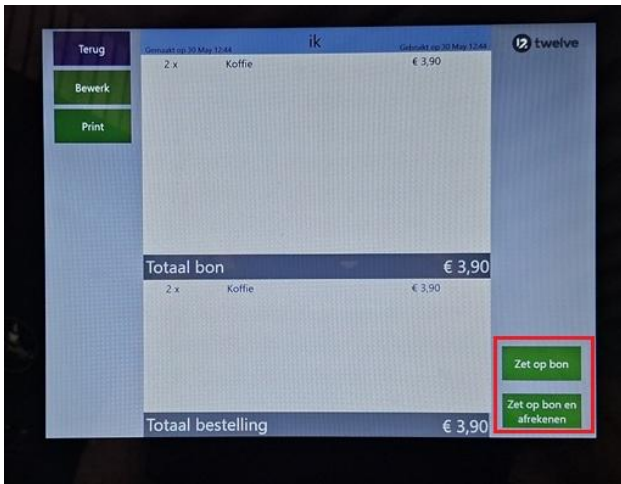
Choose existing receipt by name or create a new receipt with **'Nieuw'**.

You can use the keyboard to name a new receipt (always with the last name or a chosen name.) Choose a colour if necessary and click '**Opslaan**'. The receipt is created with its own name.

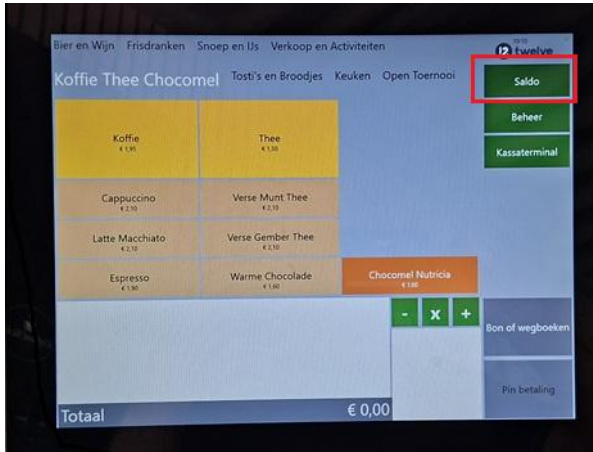
## PUT CONSUMPTIONS ON A RECEIPT.



You still need to put the consumptions on the receipt by clicking '**Zet op bon**'. The receipt has been created, or the consumptions have been put on an existing receipt.

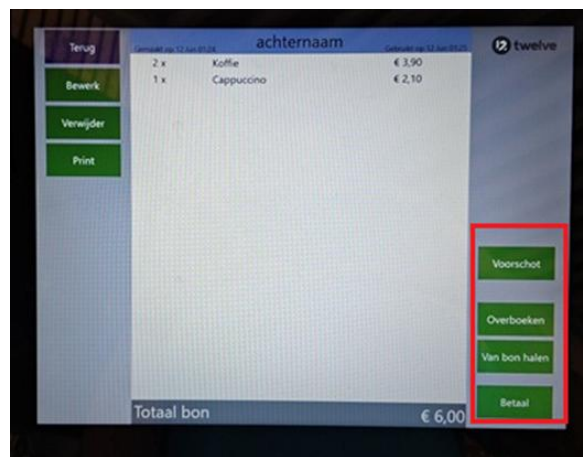
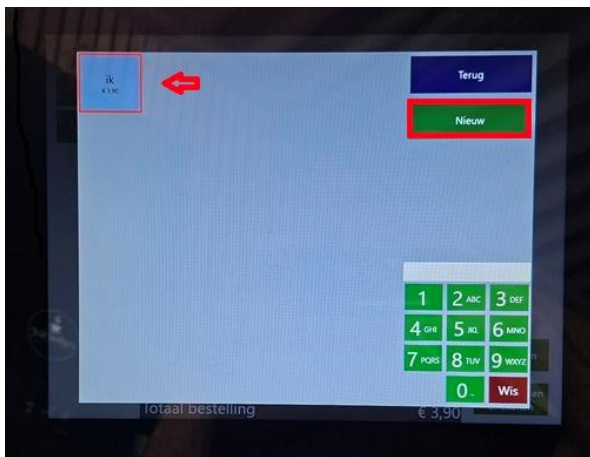
If payment is to be made after the order, choose: '**Zet op bon en afrekenen**'.

## CHECKOUT A RECEIPT.



To check out an existing receipt, press the **'Saldo'** button in the top right-hand corner of the screen.

## CHOOSE THE CORRECT RECEIPT.



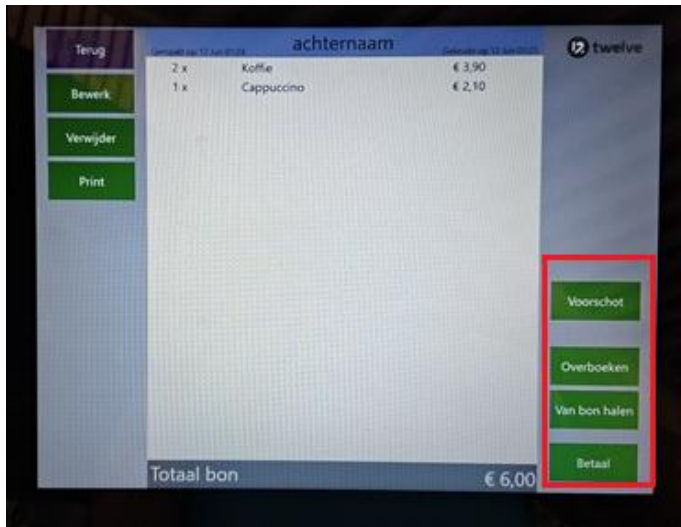
Click on the receipt to be paid, then select **'Betaal'** and PIN.

You can also share a receipt, see next page.

Any unpaid receipts are kept.

## SHARE A RECEIPT.

A receipt can also be paid in parts.



Select '**Voorschot**' and enter a part of the amount.

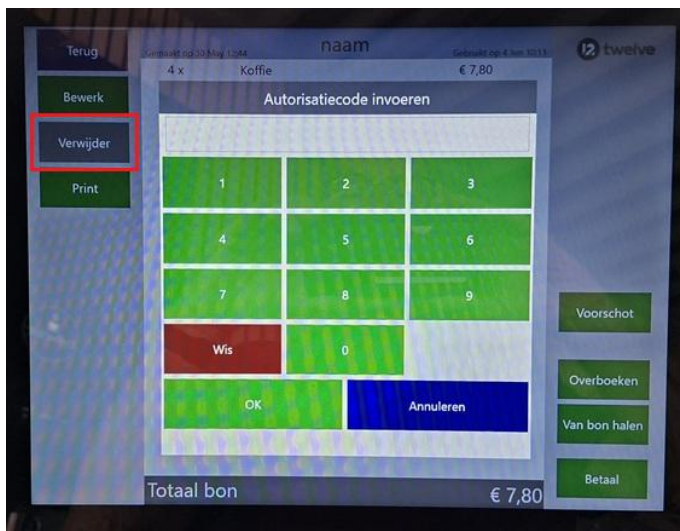
This amount can then be paid by using '**Betaal**' and PIN. And the remaining part.

This means that the receipt can be paid in several parts.

## TO DELETE A RECEIPT.

**If a receipt has been entered incorrectly or by mistake, it can be deleted.**

Please note that a deleted receipt cannot be restored. Re-enter the consumptions if necessary.






A receipt can be deleted with Autorisatiecode 2324.

To delete an entire receipt, Select 'Verwijder', enter the authorisationcode (2324) and then select 'OK'

**After the bar service:**

Clean the screen with the spray can that is in the white cabinet under the bar.

## FRYING PAN



### **Do not defrost chips and snacks first**

Turn the fryer on with the grey knob by turning it clockwise to 180 degrees. (No higher!)

Wait until the orange light goes out, the fat is then at the right temperature.

Does the orange light not go out? Look on the next page under malfunction.

### **Pan on the right: for chips only.**

The chips containers are under the baking tray. Chip colander is in the cupboard under the fryer.

### **Pan on the left: For snacks only.**

**In the event of a malfunction** (if the oil or griddle does not heat up)

See next page.

## BAKING PLATE.

Set the griddle to the desired temperature; when the orange light goes out, the set temperature has been reached. Put a little oil on the griddle and you are ready to fry.

Use the weight to press a hamburger, for example. Above the griddle hang the kitchen utensils for use.

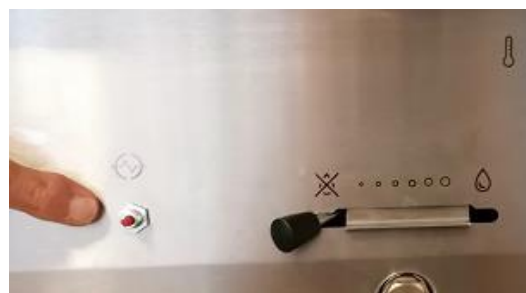


### To clean.

Scrape the oil and sludge with a putty knife into the bottom left gutter to drain.

Wipe the baking tray with a piece of cleaning paper from the roll. The last bar shift must clean the tray.

**In the event of a malfunction** (if the oil or griddle does not heat up), the fuse must be reset. Turn the knobs off again and unscrew the black knobs. Press the red reset buttons. Turn the knobs of the fryer and griddle back on.



## MICROWAVE, defrost sandwich in the microwave.



### Notice,

First remove plastic foil.

Place the sandwich on a plate in the microwave, press the start button, it will turn off automatically after 30 seconds.

**Toast a sandwich see page 17.**

## OVEN.



### **For baking**

Bread, for example.

Right: baking time button  
Left: temperature knob

## EXTRACTION HOOD, buttons top right.



### **To turn on:**

Press the On button.

Use the +/- button to set the strength of the extraction, which is possible when the dot next to the number 1 no longer flashes.

Set at least to 2.

### **To switch off:**

Press on-button briefly, extractor hood jumps to position 8 for heat dissipation and after about 1 min the fan turns off by itself.

Right button is for light on/off.

# TOASTER



First defrost the sandwich in the microwave (page 16) and switch on the toaster.

Place the sandwich in the sandwich clamp.



## Selector button for bottom/middle and middle/top heating

Use the position below with a maximum of 3 toasted sandwiches. That is the position in this photo.



## Time setting selector,

Set it to position 4 and turn the Tosti clamp after 2 minutes Watch out for the heat!!

The sandwich is ready when it has turned brown, and the cheese has melted.

With 1 to 3 sandwiches the heating is only lower/middle, with more sandwiches lower/top.



## RINSE MACHINE / DISHWASHER



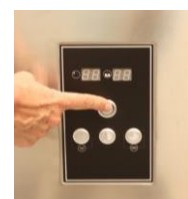
The rinsing machine is equipped with a feed table with sink and pre-rinse shower. This is a kind of shower head used to quickly pre-rinse dirty dishes. There are several baskets especially for plates, cutlery, and glassware. The baskets can be pushed through easily. Hood can be opened and closed. After a few minutes, the dishes are ready, the basket can be pushed through to the disposal table and the dishes can be put away.

## RINSING MACHINE OPERATION:



**Preheating rinsing machine:**

**Close the hood** and Press the power button.



**Next, Open the hood** and wait until the machine is up to temperature: Left 80/90 degrees and right > 50 degrees. This takes about 15/20 minutes.

# RINSE THE DIRTY DISHES WITH THE RINSE TAP BEFORE YOU PUT IT IN THE RINSING MACHINE!



Slide the basket into the dishwasher.  
Close the hood and press the left button, wait for till the light goes out, this takes about 2 minutes. (Or the noise stops)  
Open the hood and slide out the basket.  
Let clean dishes dry and cool off before cleaning up



## AT THE END OF THE BARD SERVICE. (LAST SHIFT ONLY!)



Emptying the flushing machine:  
Hood up, press the left button longer (you will hear the machine start to pump) and then remove the gray plug.



Wait until the machine has been pumped empty, this will take about 5 minutes.  
Press and hold the On button to switch off the device.  
Put the gray plug back in place (is a bit tricky). Leave hood open.

**Always switch off the machine after emptying!**

## BEER TAP.



Put a drop of beer glass cleaner in the sink. Water comes out of the right tap. The tap on the left is for rinsing the glass, open it when it is busy. Use the correct glasses for the kind of beer.

## CLEANING GRILLS AND DRAINAGE.

After the last round, remove the 2 grids at the beer tap and the drip grid. Rinse it in the kitchen with the flush tap.

Fill a jug with hot water and some suds and pour it into the beer gutter and under the drip grid. This is important because of fruit flies!

Also clean the container with skimmers. The placemats on the bar also need to be rinsed.

If someone else comes for a beer afterwards, put a tray under the tap.

Do not forget to clean the beer sink with detergent.

## REPLACEMENT OF BEER BARRELS.

The barrel fridge is under the tap with two doors, open the doors to change a barrel.



### Replacing a beer barrel,

Lift out the empty barrel.

Squeeze the black bottom and pull the handle further up.

Then slide it towards you and it will come off. (Do not apply force!)

## REMOVING THE BEER HOSE.



Press the button on the side of the tap.  
Pull the tube out of the orange slot and then pull the white tube through the tap from below.

**Take a new barrel with the oldest best before date** (see label on the barrel!)  
Remove the silver sticker on top of the barrel!

You push the tube that is attached to the barrel from below through the correct hole to the tap. Click the orange part in the right place (recess) and close the cover again.

Take the carbon dioxide connection with the red hose (the lever remains up). Make sure the red and white hoses are on top of each other .

Now slide the coupling part onto the keg and push the handle down.

Put the barrel back, close the doors and then remove the plastic cap from the hose.

Make sure there are always enough barrels in the refrigerator compartment. Make sure there is one extra barrel of each kind of beer in the refrigerator compartment. Place the empty barrel in the barrel storage area right next to the kitchen.

**REPLACING CARBON ACID:** Gray cylinder bottle with chain around it.



Close the top knob first. Then unscrew the hose (see white arrow) Then loosen the chain. Grab a new carbon dioxide bottle. Secure it with the chain.

Reconnect the hose to the cylinder and turn the top knob back on.

**THE CARBON CYLINDER MUST stand behind the chain.**  
(Safety notice)

# CONTROL OF COURT LIGHTING with phone or the tablet in the corridor.



The Ralph App on the mobile phone can be used to control the court lighting.  
(Mobile in the drawer by the coffee machine) pin code; 1982

The tablet in the corridor next to the notice board can also be used to control the court lighting.

On the screen, you can use the slider at the top right of the court group to turn the court lighting on or off for each group.

Slider to LEFT= lights off

to RIGHT= lights on

When the slider and racket logo is green, the court lights are on.

At 23:05, the court lighting switches off.

## **IF THE RALPH APP or WIFI DOES NOT WORK,**

CONTROL THE TENNIS COURT LIGHTING WITH THE SWITCH IN THE METER CABINET.

There is a switch in the meter cupboard at the back left of the corridor near the emergency exit to switch the lighting on or off if the Perfect Play App does not work. The key for the meter cupboard is the same as the work cupboard key behind the bar. With this switch you can switch the lighting on or off, the lighting is always on or off.

**Make sure that you also turn off the lighting with this switch.**

**The lighting does not switch off automatically!**



It is a touch switch, touch the metal part next to the desired tennis court group.

### **TURNING THE LIGHTS ON OR OFF.**
