- You have not received food from any other Consortium food pantry in the past 28-30 days. (See list below.) To check eligibility, call 812-401-0606 (Mon.-Fri., 8:30am-3:30pm).

WHAT TO BRING

- Valid ID for the person picking up food
- The original Social Security card (paper, not a digital version) for *EACH person in each household receiving food*
