

# Share-A-Thon Contest

*Share Your Extension or Workflow — Inspire the Community*

In the spirit of TheUserGroup.org (TUG), the **Share-A-Thon** invites any TUG member customer company to submit an internally developed extension or workflow built on Infor CSD, CSDE, or OS — one that demonstrates measurable business value and is ready for real-world implementation. Selected submissions will be shared with the broader TUG community, and a winner will be chosen by a panel of judges.

## Definitions

<b>App Builder / Mongoose</b>	Infor's low-code development tools for building custom UI screens, mobile apps, and lightweight applications on the Infor OS platform.
<b>Extension</b>	Custom logic or a UI addition that changes how the system works — expanding or modifying the platform's built-in capabilities
<b>ION Workflow</b>	Infor's native integration and workflow engine tool used to orchestrate approvals, notifications, and cross-application process flows.
<b>UI</b>	User interface
<b>Workflow</b>	A process automation built inside the Infor platform — a procedure that moves data, triggers actions, or streamlines an existing business process
<b>XtendM3</b>	Infor's extension framework tool for CSD/CSDE, used to add custom business logic, validations, and calculations without modifying base code.

## Eligibility

- Open to any TUG member customer company.
- Limit of one submission per developer at a customer company.
- Members of the TUG Board of Directors and judging panel are not eligible to submit entries they developed.

## What to Submit

Your submission package must include all of the following:

<b>Operating Service (OS)</b>	<b>Custom Mobile App for Warehouse Checks (App Builder / Mongoose)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lightweight mobile app for cycle counts</li> <li>Custom UI for scanning barcodes</li> <li>Dashboard showing discrepancies</li> <li>Integration back to CSD/CSDE via ION APIs</li> </ul>	<b>Supplier Onboarding (ION Workflow)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trigger when a new supplier record is created</li> <li>Route tasks to AP, Purchasing, and Legal</li> <li>Collect required documents</li> <li>Update status in the Supplier Master</li> <li>Notify the requester when onboarding is complete</li> </ul>

- Company name
- Core Infor platform: CSD, CSDE, or OS

### Developer Information

- Developer name and title
- Contact information

### Business Case

- Identify the business case and the target end user(s) the solution serves

### Solution Summary

- Overall development completion time
- Source code (required)
- Supporting documentation: screenshots, form samples, or a short recording (5 minutes or less)
- Description of business value delivered

## How Entries Are Judged

A panel of judges will evaluate all eligible submissions using the following weighted criteria:

Weight	Criterion	What the Judges Are Looking For
25%	Business Value	Measurable outcomes and return on investment

<b>20%</b>	<b>Innovation</b>	Creativity and uniqueness of the workflow or extension
<b>20%</b>	<b>Execution Quality</b>	Completeness, clarity, and usability of the solution
<b>20%</b>	<b>End User Experience</b>	Relevance and practical value for the intended user
<b>15%</b>	<b>Presentation</b>	Clarity and quality of the solution summary

## Contestant Recognitions

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The winner will be announced at the TUG Hall of Fame Awards Dinner on Sunday, May 17. The winner does not need to be present to win.

- All contestants receive an invitation to the TUG Hall of Fame Awards Dinner
- Winner receives a TUG Hall of Fame Award and Gift Card

## Terms & Conditions

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### 1. Acceptance of Terms

By registering for and participating in the TUG Share-A-Thon, you agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions (the "Agreement"). If you do not agree, please do not participate in the Share-A-Thon.

### 2. Eligibility

2.1. The Share-A-Thon is open to individuals aged 18 and above and must be employed by a current TUG Member company.

2.2. Members of the TUG Board of Directors and Share-A-Thon judges are ineligible.

### 3. Submission and Participation

3.1. Submission is free and must be completed through the official Share-A-Thon website.

3.2. The submission period is from April 17, 2026, to May 8, 2026.

3.3. Participants must have developed the entry no earlier than May 2025.

3.4. TUG reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any participant or team.

3.5. You acknowledge that your submission was developed entirely by employees of your company, without the aid of any third-party company or individual.

3.6. You acknowledge that your submission was developed using resources provided by Infor CSD, CSDE or iOS.

3.7. TUG reserves the right to verify eligibility and to adjudicate on any dispute at any time. The Share-A-Thon is subject to all federal, state, and local laws and is void where prohibited.

3.8. Submissions must include a running version of the solution and a written description. Video demonstrations are optional but recommended.

### 4. Intellectual Property Rights

4.1. By submitting an entry to the TUG Connects Share-A-Thon, the submitting individual and their company agree to share the entry's source code with TUG members, and acknowledge that neither TUG, Infor nor the developer or the developer's company shall be held liable for any damages, technical malfunctions, errors, or failure of the solution to perform as described that may arise from its use or implementation.

4.2. You represent and warrant that your project does not infringe upon the Intellectual Property Rights of any third party.

### 5. Judging and Prizes

5.1. Projects will be judged based on criteria announced at the start of the Share-A-Thon.

- 5.2. The Judges' decisions are final and binding.
- 5.3. Prizes are non-transferable and non-exchangeable.

## 8. Privacy and Data Protection

8.1. By participating, you consent to the collection and use of your personal information for the purposes of conducting and promoting the Share-A-Thon. This will include your name, company, title, and email address.
