Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate Passion Sunday, often referred to as Palm Sunday. Blessed Palms are available to recall Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Then at the Gospel we read the Passion of Jesus as recorded in the Gospel of Matthew. Today we begin Holy Week. This week is given to us to recall and reflect upon the Passion of Jesus Christ. On Holy Thursday we recall the Lord's Last Supper where he instituted the Eucharist and the priesthood upon his disciples. We recall his agony in the Garden and his arrest.

On Good Friday we recall his passion again, this time from the Gospel of John. Then on Holy Saturday we renew our baptismal promises, and we hear the Gospel account of the Resurrection. Celebrating the Paschal Triduum helps us to grow in faith and to give our lives over to the Risen One. May we learn to live and give of ourselves in a way that witnesses to Christ and to his Church.
