Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate Father's Day. We honor our fathers and thank God for all their leadership and discipline that they imparted into us their children. In the Gospel this week Jesus speaks of the Heavenly Father's care for us and for creation. God is often seen as creator and first cause of the universe, but with philosophy is not seen as a providential guide and ruler of the cosmos.
