Dear Parishioners,
We celebrate this weekend, Trinity Sunday. After the Easter Season is completed and we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Church at Pentecost, we open the next Sunday of Ordinary Time with the celebration of Trinity Sunday. God in unity shares power and authority and sovereignty in three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The great prayer of the angels has three holies. God in any of the persons does what is common to all the persons. Sometimes referred to as God acts through the Father in the Son and with the Holy Spirit. It is not easy for us to understand the trinity and there are many analogies that help us to understand. St. Patrick used a simple three leafed shamrock to describe the trinity. Others have used water and its three phases of solid, liquid, and steam. The Church Fathers used the speaking person to capture the power and dimensions of the Three Persons; in the Speaker as the Father; the Word spoken as the Son; and the breath was the Holy Spirit.

As we come to know God, we learn to relate to them in the individuality and uniqueness of the Life of the Trinity. When Jesus the Son revealed God to us, he made God known to us as the Father in heaven and the Holy Spirit who was sent by the Father and the Son after Jesus ascended to heaven.

Three Persons and One God fully united is a mystery to us and yet revealed to us in faith. God is One and yet we may worship any of the persons of the Trinity and worship God in his wholeness and Oneness simultaneously. Honor for the Son is honor to the Father and honor for the Holy Spirit is honor for both God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. Note only one God, but three unique persons united in the One God. A trinity of persons. Not three Gods but only one.
