What Greater Gift Can You Give?

When someone passes away, extend them a Plenary Indulgence. Those who are released by your prayers and sacrifices are full of gratitude and will be your prayer partners forever.

Conditions for a Plenary Indulgence:

Be in the state of grace. Receive Communion each time a plenary indulgence is sought. Go to Confession within 20 days before or after doing the prescribed work. Be detached from sin, even venial sin. Pray for the intentions of the Pope, preferably 1 Hail Mary and 1 Our Father. Have a general intention to gain a plenary indulgence. Fulfill one of the following:

- -At least 1/2 hr of adoration of Blessed Sacrament
- -or family or group Rosary
- -or private Rosary before the Blessed Sacrament
- -or at least 1/2 hr of pious reading of Sacred Scripture
- -or walking the Stations of the Cross in a church or with properly erected display of the Stations
