The application process with the City of Guymon is quite lengthy and very strictly regulated by several local, state, and federal employment guidelines/regulations. While we have made every effort to simplify and expedite the selection process, many equal opportunity, affirmative action, and merit system provisions must be monitored.

Please read the following guidelines carefully before completing the application form. These guidelines are strictly enforced and adhered to. Complete all areas in their entirety, as applicable. <u>An incomplete application is unacceptable.</u>

<u>NOTICE</u>: Certain jobs are classified as "safety sensitive" as defined by the United States Department of Transportation drug, alcohol testing regulations, The Oklahoma Standards for Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Act and/or Oklahoma Medical Marijuana laws. Marijuana is on of the substances included in the drug panel screening. Possession of a medical marijuana license will not excuse you for the testing process, or the consequences of testing positive for marijuana. If you have questions about whether the position you are applying for is classified as "safety sensitive" please consult with the HR Department.

<u>DRUG SCREEN TEST</u>: You will be required to take a pre-employment drug screening test for employment consideration in accordance with the Oklahoma Standards for Workplace Drug and Alcohol Testing Act, The Mental Health Consortium, and the City of Guymon Drug-Free Workplace Policy.

<u>CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK</u>: A criminal background check is required. This report will only be run after you have been offered a position with the City of Guymon. It will be done by a company we have contracted. You must sign a form allowing us to verify your credentials.

<u>DRIVING STANDARDS</u>: If the position for which you are applying has, as an essential job function, the operating of a City of Guymon vehicle, or may require driving a City of Guymon vehicle, you must possess a properly classified, valid driver's license and your driving record must meet the following driving standards:

- 1. No more than four (4) points on your driving record
- 2. Possess the proper classification of driver's license for the job for which you are applying.
- 3. Possess and maintain a valid driver's license during your employment with the City of Guymon and maintain a driving record with no more than four (4) points.
- 4. Must meet the approval of insurance carrier.

Applicants for employment with the City of Guymon will have a MVR (Motor Vehicle Report) run by the same company, prior to full time employment with the City of Guymon.

<u>NEPOTISM:</u> In accordance with the Policy and Procedure manual, "No two individuals related by blood or marriage to the third degree shall be employed within the same lines of supervision or work unit in a department. Relatives of department heads and division heads shall not be hired within the same department."

IMMIGRATION REFORM AND CONTROL ACT OF 1986: In accordance with the United States code, Title 8, Section 132A, the City of Guymon must verify every individual's eligibility of employment in the United States. The Immigration and Naturalization Service and the United States Department of Labor require you to furnish the City of Guymon with document verification of employment eligibility.

At such time you are extended an offer of employment, you will be required to furnish documentation. Failure to furnish the City of Guymon with the requested documentation will result in dying you employment with the city of Guymon.

A SUMMARY OF YOUR RUNDER UNDER the FAIR CREDIT REPORTING ACT

.The Federal Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) promotes the accuracy, fairness, and privacy of information in the files of consumer reporting agencies. There are many types of consumer reporting agencies, including credit bureaus, and specialty agencies (such as agencies that sell information about check writing histories, medical records, and rental history records). Here is a summary of your major rights under the FCRA. For more information, including information additional rights, go to www.ftc.gov/credit or write to: Consumer Response Center, Room 130-A, Federal Trade Commission, 600 Pennsylvania Ave. N.W., Washington, D.C. 20580.

- You must be told information in your file has been used against you. Anyone that uses a credit report or another type of consumer report t deny your application for credit, insurance, and employment to take another adverse action against you must tell you, and must give you the name, address, and phone null 1 ber of the agency that provided the information.
- You have the right to know what is in your file. You may obtain all the information about you in the files of a consumer reporting agency (your "file disclosure"). You will be required to provide proper identification, which may include your Social Security number. In many cases, the disclosure will be free. You are entitled to a free disclosure if:
 - a person has taken adverse action again you because, of the information in your credit report;
 - you are the victim of identity theft and place a fraud alert in your file:
 - your file contains inaccurate information as a result of fraud;
 - you are unemployed but expect to apply for employment within 60 days.

In addition, by September 2005 all consumers will be entitled to one free disclosure every 12 months upon request from each nationwide credit bureau and from nationwide specialty consumer reporting agencies. See www.ftc.gov/credit for additional information.

- You have the right to ask for a credit score. Credit score are numerical summaries of your credit-worthiness based on information from credit bureaus: You may request a credit score form consumer reporting agencies that create scores or disclose score or residential real property loans, but you will have to pay for it. In some mortgage transactions, you will receive credit score) information for free from the mortgage lender.
- Consumer reporting agencies must correct or delete inaccurate, incomplete, or unverifiable information. Inaccurate, incomplete, or unverifiable information must be removed or corrected, usually within 30 days. However, a consumer reporting agency may continue to report information it has verified as accurate.
- Consumer reporting agencies may not report outdated negative information. In most cases, a consumer reporting agency may not report negative information that is more than seven years old, or bankruptcies that are more than 10 years old.
- Access to your file is limited. A consumer reporting agency may provide information about you only to people with a valid need usually to consider an application with a creditor, insurer, employer, landlord, and other business. The FCRA specifies those with a valid need for access.
- You must give your consent for report to be provided to employers. A consumer reporting agency may not give out information about you to your employer, or a potential employer, without your written consent given to the employer. - You may limit "prescreened" offers of credit and insurance you get based on information on your credit report.
