As we move into another week at St. Anthony, we are reminded that every day matters.

Not every day will be perfect. Some days will be full of excitement and accomplishments, while others may bring challenges, mistakes, or moments when we need to try again. But every day gives our students a new opportunity to learn, grow, make a difference, and become a little more of the person God created them to be.

The little things matter, too— a kind word to a friend, a teacher taking extra time to help a student, a parent asking, “How was your day?”, or a child choosing to try again when something feels difficult.

At St. Anthony, we believe that growth happens one day at a time. We may not always see the progress immediately, but each lesson learned, each act of kindness, and each new challenge helps shape our students into confident, caring, and capable young people.

Thank you for trusting us to be part of your child's journey. We are grateful for another week to learn, grow, pray, and make every day count— together.





It always amazes me what memories the brain holds on to. Some thoughts seem so silly or insignificant, yet, just like a catchy jingle that you can't get out of your head, they pop up at the most random times. This week, as I was walking down the hallway, I was reminded of a family vacation when I was around four.

My mom's side of the family always vacationed together every June. That particular year, we rented a house on the beach in Florida. My brother and I shared a room. As we tried to fall asleep, my family laughed and talked loudly in the kitchen. My older brother whined and said, "I wish they would just stop talking so I could fall asleep. Jess, will you ask them to be quiet?" I remember standing up tall, taking a deep breath in, and bravely walking into the kitchen.

I walked up to my family and said, "Can you stop talking? We are trying to sleep!" My Uncle Dave, without even a moment of hesitation, responded, "Why don't you stop sleeping? We are trying to talk!" My family laughed hysterically. Immediately, my cheeks flushed a deep red. I felt the heat rise with every breath. My stomach twisted into knots. It felt like a spotlight had been turned on me, and my confidence melted like ice. Needless to say, I was so embarrassed I wanted to disappear. I remember turning around without saying a word, walking back into the bedroom, and telling my brother, "Put a pillow over your ears because they are definitely not going to stop talking." That's the first time I remember feeling embarrassed.

In kindergarten, I had my first wiggly tooth. Back in the early '90s, I only had to attend kindergarten in the afternoon. (I miss that). My aunt tried all morning to pull my tooth out with no luck, so when I sat in my tiny kindergarten chair that afternoon, I pulled and twisted that sucker every chance I got. As my teacher read aloud a story, I twisted my tooth so hard it made a massive popping sound. (In all seriousness, I have no idea what happened! That is the only time I have ever heard a sound like that in my life.)

My teacher, Mrs. Bennett, stopped reading, and before I could blink, the entire kindergarten class turned and stared at me wide-eyed. In that moment, I felt so embarrassed that it was like a blanket of heat covered me. My ears burned. My heart felt like it was going to thump out of my chest. Mrs. Bennett told me to go to the water fountain and rinse my mouth. Next to the water fountain was a door to the playground, and it took everything in my five-year-old body not to run for it. I remember walking back to the classroom as slowly as I could and standing outside the classroom door, trying to build up the bravery to walk back in- embarrassment at its finest.

In the 7th grade, my school had a Slush Puppie slushie machine in the center of the lunchroom filled to the brim with strawberry slushy. I recall the day I finally felt brave enough to walk through the lunchroom to get one. When I pulled the lever, something malfunctioned (or I was just a total idiot, who knows?) and red, sticky slushy flew out of that machine at a speed of at least 75 miles per hour and covered my entire body from head to toe. I stood there frozen for way too long while laughter filled the lunchroom. I instantly felt clammy. I wanted to disappear. I had a rush of self-consciousness and ran out of the lunchroom as fast as my sticky little body would allow. (Fun fact: Ever since that day, I break out into an immediate cold sweat whenever I see a strawberry slushy. Please don't test that out- I promise it's true.)

Isaiah 41:10 states, "Do not fear for I am with you." This verse offers reassurance and strength from God. The meaning centers on God's promise to be a constant, powerful, and supportive presence, capable of overcoming any fear, embarrassment, or hardship. This verse encourages us to trust God's presence, rely on His strength, find comfort in His character, and remember that when we feel overwhelmed by embarrassment, God is with us, offering strength and support. How lucky are we?

I recall very vividly, after each of these embarrassing moments, lying in bed, mortified at the thought of a new day. From as early as four, I thought I would never recover from the feeling of embarrassment. At four years old, as my brother snored away in the bed next to me, I stared at the ceiling wide-eyed, wondering how I would ever persevere past that moment of shame. In kindergarten, I knew there was no way I would ever be able to show my face at afternoon kindergarten again, and in seventh grade, I begged my parents to homeschool me. I'd find myself praying about my desperate need for a new life before eventually falling asleep. Somehow, eventually, the feeling of embarrassment always faded away, but my relationship with God through prayer always remained.

When was the last time you felt embarrassed? Was God a part of your recovery plan? How can you help your children rely on God during times when their world feels like it is undoubtedly going to end because of embarrassment?

As we conclude another week together, know you and your children are in my prayers to feel God's reassurance and powerful presence exactly when you need it most. If there is anything I can do for you or your children, please be in touch.

With embarrassing stories on my mind (why do I do this to myself), gratitude for God's continual supportive presence (especially when I make a fool out of myself), and zero desire for a strawberry slushie (my palms are sweating just thinking about it- I'm not even kidding),

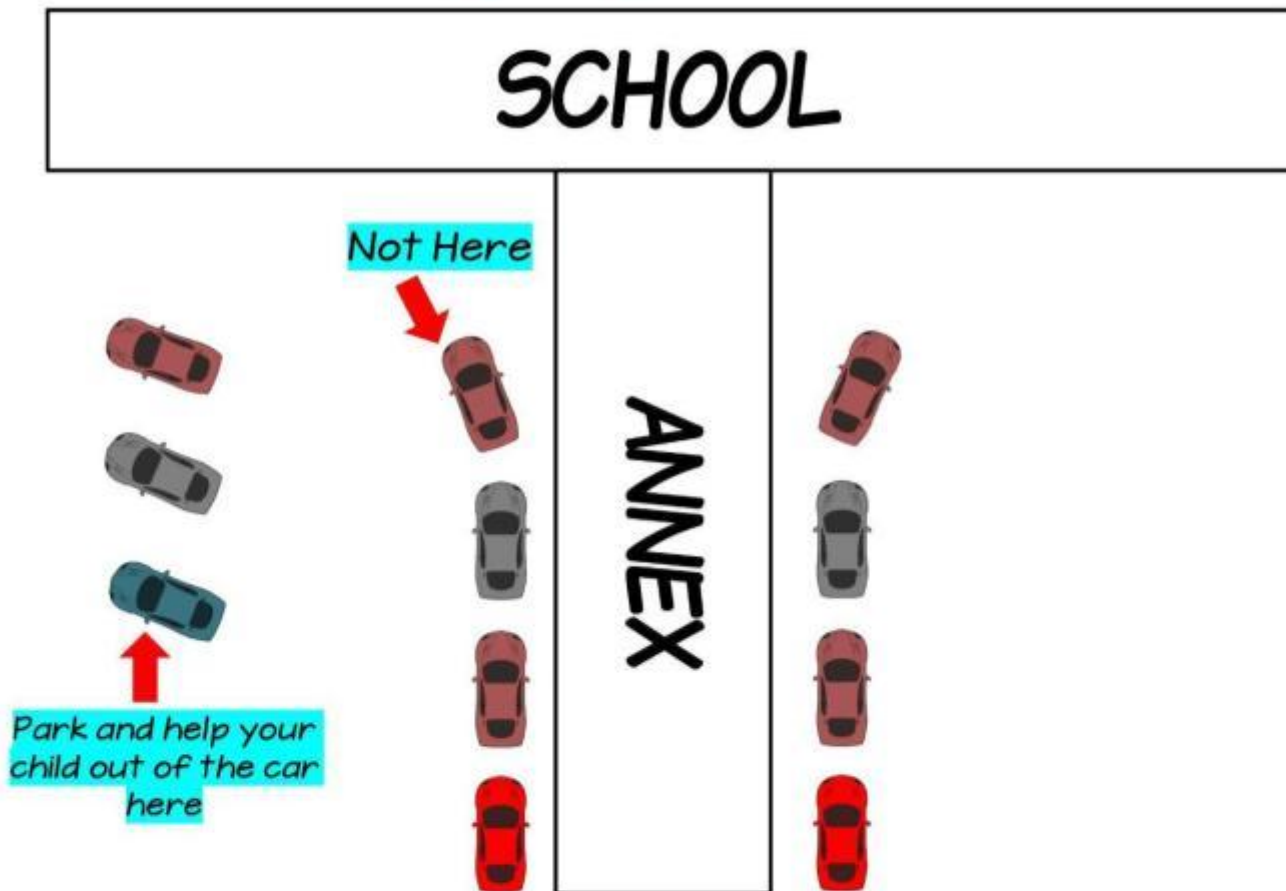

After School Care Updates

2026–2027 After-School Care Program & Fee Schedule

For the 2026–2027 school year, After-School Care fees will be managed through **FACTS**, alongside student tuition and other school fees. All families must complete the After School Care Registration Form, even those already enrolled in the program.

Program Hours

Regular After-School Care:

School dismissal – 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, on regular school days.

After-School Care is not available on days when school is closed, including scheduled holidays, school breaks, weather closures, or other days designated by the school.

Parents must pick up their children by **6:00 p.m.**

Registration & Enrollment

Families who plan to use After-School Care on a regular basis should register their child(ren) through FACTS and select the anticipated number of days of care needed each week.

Families may select:

- **2 days per week**
- **3 days per week**
- **4–5 days per week**
- **Drop-in/occasional care**, when space is available

When registering, families should provide their anticipated weekly schedule. We understand that work and family schedules can change, and our program is designed to provide reasonable flexibility.

Regular program fees are based on 10 monthly payments through FACTS.



What does the monthly fee cover?

The monthly fee reserves your child's place in the After-School Care program and helps St. Anthony maintain appropriate staffing and supervision throughout the school year.

The monthly fee is not based on the exact number of days a child attends in a given month. Therefore, regular monthly fees are due regardless of occasional absences, early pickups, family vacations, or other days a child does not attend.

Drop-In Care

Drop-in care is available for families who need occasional After-School Care but do not require a regular weekly schedule.

Drop-In Rate: \$20 per day, per child.

Drop-in care is subject to available space and appropriate staffing.

Parents should contact the school office or designated After-School Care contact as early as possible when requesting drop-in care. Drop-in care is not guaranteed until the school confirms availability. Drop-in charges will be billed through FACTS.

Changing Your Weekly Schedule

We understand that family and work schedules change.

Families enrolled in regular After-School Care may request a change to their weekly schedule by providing **at least two weeks' notice**.

Schedule changes are subject to available space and staffing requirements.

A schedule change may result in a change to the family's monthly fee beginning with the next applicable billing period.

Families who temporarily need additional days may request drop-in care at the applicable drop-in rate, subject to availability.

Sibling Discount

Families with more than one child enrolled in regular After-School Care will receive a sibling discount.

- **First child:** Full applicable monthly rate
- **Second child:** 10% discount
- **Third and additional children:** 25% discount

Sibling discounts apply to regular monthly After-School Care fees and do not apply to drop-in care.



Billing Through FACTS

After-School Care fees will be billed through the family's FACTS account.

Families may select an available FACTS payment option, including payment arrangements offered through the school's FACTS system.

Regular monthly fees will continue based on the family's selected enrollment level, regardless of occasional absences or days when a child is picked up before 6:00 p.m.

Drop-in charges and other applicable After-School Care charges will also be billed through FACTS.

Pickup & Authorized Adults

Children must be picked up by **6:00 p.m.**

For the safety of our students, we may release children only to a parent/guardian or an adult authorized by the parent/guardian.

Families should notify the school if someone other than a regularly authorized adult will be picking up their child.

School Closures & Cancellations

After-School Care will not operate when school is officially closed unless the school announces otherwise.

If school is dismissed early because of severe weather, an emergency, or another circumstance, families will receive instructions regarding After-School Care.

When school is closed, families will not be charged a separate drop-in fee for that day.

Program Expectations

Our After-School Care program is an extension of the St. Anthony School community. Students are expected to follow school rules and demonstrate respectful behavior toward staff and other students.

Students are expected to:

- Treat staff and other students with respect.
- Follow staff directions.
- Use school property and program materials appropriately.
- Remain in designated areas.
- Follow safety rules.
- Demonstrate behavior consistent with St. Anthony School expectations.

Serious or repeated behavioral concerns may result in suspension or removal from the After-School Care program.

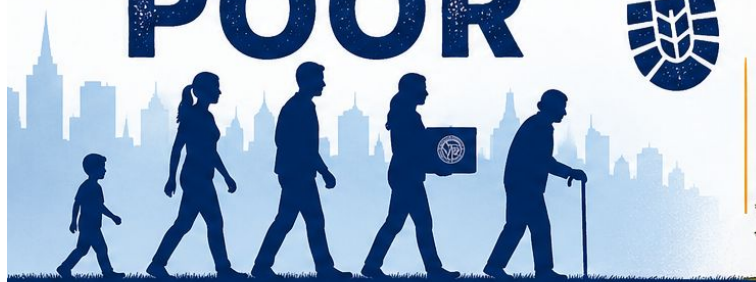
