## Tuition & Choice Scholarship Update: 26-27 School Year

We are pleased to share that for the 2026-2027 school year, tuition will increase modestly to \$7,500 which is a \$200 increase from the current year's rate of \$7,300. While any tuition increase deserves transparency, the more meaningful story is found in the numbers behind it.

Indiana's Choice Scholarship Program reimburses a portion of tuition based on each family's resident school district. For 26-27, scholarship amounts are increasing across all five of our participating districts, and in every case, those increases outpace the tuition increase itself. The result: families will actually pay less out of pocket next year than they did this year, with parent-portion savings ranging from approximately \$62-\$175 depending on your resident school district.

Additionally, please note a \$50 increase in the technology fee, from \$75 to \$125, reflecting continued investment in our academic resources.

We recognize that affordability is central to your family's decision, and we're grateful that the Choice Scholarship Program continues to make a Catholic education affordable and accessible. We have listed the specific district scholarship amounts and what the estimated amount of tuition will be for families. ## Choice Scholarship Information 2026-2027

St. Anthony School has been approved as a Choice Scholarship School in the State of Indiana. We may now begin the application process for families. As you are aware, the Choice Scholarship Program will become Universal next school year. This means that ALL families in the state of Indiana will qualify for the Choice Scholarship.

- Families will need to complete the Choice Application Form and send in proof of Indiana Residency. Examples for proof of residency are listed below.
- **Examples of Proof of Residency:**
  - *Bank Statement, Credit Card Bill, Loan Statement, Lease Agreement, Mortgage, Rental Contract, Property Deed, Tax Bill, Voter Registration, Driver's License, Homeowners/Auto/Renters Policy, Utility Bill, Tax Returns*

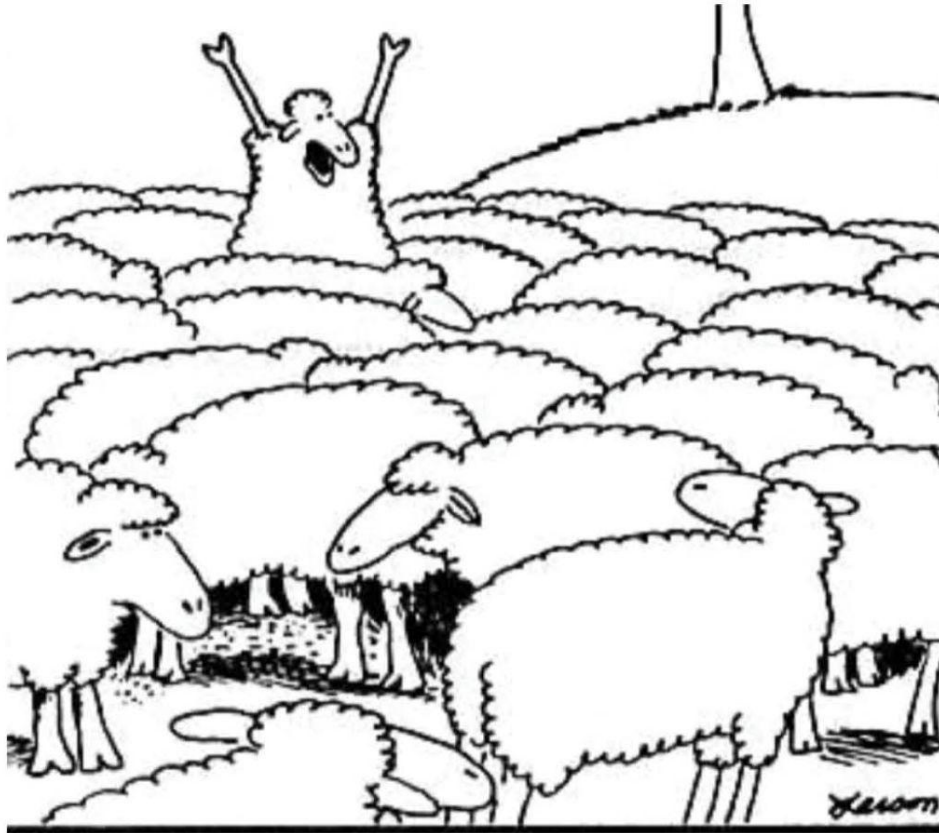

# GONE fishing

Mt. 4:19 "Follow me," he told them, "and I will make you fishers of people!"



Today's Gospel presents Jesus as the gate retaining the sheepfold in one flock. Whoever goes in and out through him will be safe and find pasture. Shifting the image just a little, I would like you to think of the doors to our homes. They let us in where we find safety and family. They close out people who shouldn't be there. They let us go out so we can meet friends or make a living or buy things we need or do something fun. Doors and gates are important. And so is Jesus. When he is part of our comings and goings, when we make him central in our lives, when we ask his blessing on all our activities, our life will be secure and our happiness will be ensured.

Does this mean we will always be safe in this world? Bad things do happen to good people as we all know. And even some of Jesus' good friends suffered, some were even put to death. But it's not just to protect us in this world that Jesus came. The last verse in today's gospel is worth memorizing. Jesus said, "I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly." Why doesn't Jesus keep bad things from happening to those who are faithful to him? That's a profound question, but one answer could be that life in this world is not where the abundant life can be found. And the reason Jesus comes is so we can have abundant life. Even if we have looks, popularity, health, wealth, youth, wisdom and everything else our hearts desire, we don't "have it all." We'll always feel some emptiness in our hearts, because our hearts were made for perfect union with God, and we won't know what that's like until we get to heaven. And that's where Christ our shepherd wants to lead us and that's why he came to us.

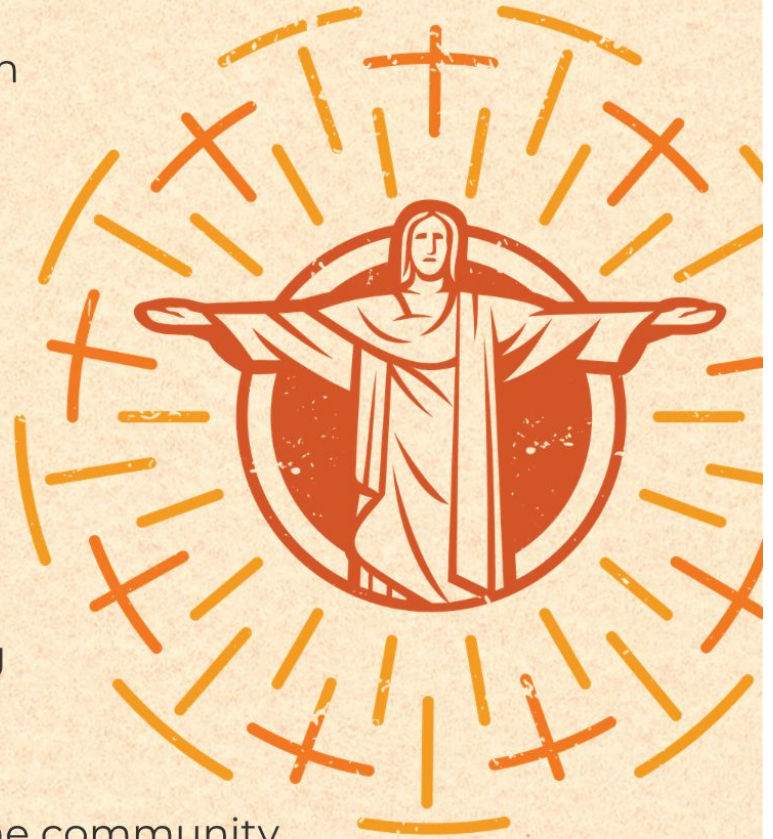

Trivia Answer: B

Erector was first envisioned by Alfred Carlton Gilbert (A.C. Gilbert) in 1911, as he rode the train from New Haven to New York City. This section of track was being converted to electrical power, and Gilbert watched as steel girders were erected to carry the power lines, inspiring him to develop the toy. Gilbert was a skilled magician and manufactured magic tricks and magic sets with his existing company the "Mysto Manufacturing Company." The first Erector set was made there in 1913, called "The Erector / Structural Steel and Electro-Mechanical Builder", and labeled as "Educational, Instructive and Amusing." The toy was first introduced and sold to the public in 1913 at the Toy Fair held at the Broadway Central Hotel in New York City. In the 1993 film *The Sandlot*, the characters use components from an Erector Set in their contraption to retrieve a baseball, which nearly successfully helps them avoid "The Beast."
