Tuition & Choice Scholarship Update: 26-27 School Year

We are pleased to share that for the 2026-2027 school year, tuition will increase modestly to \$7,500 which is a \$200 increase from the current year's rate of \$7,300. While any tuition increase deserves transparency, the more meaningful story is found in the numbers behind it.

Indiana's Choice Scholarship Program reimburses a portion of tuition based on each family's resident school district. For 26-27, scholarship amounts are increasing across all five of our participating districts, and in every case, those increases outpace the tuition increase itself. The result: families will actually pay less out of pocket next year than they did this year, with parent-portion savings ranging from approximately \$62-\$175 depending on your resident school district.

Additionally, please note a \$50 increase in the technology fee, from \$75 to \$125, reflecting continued investment in our academic resources.

We recognize that affordability is central to your family's decision, and we're grateful that the Choice Scholarship Program continues to make a Catholic education affordable and accessible. We have listed the specific district scholarship amounts and what the estimated amount of tuition will be for families. Memorizing the 7 Gifts of Pentecost

Have you ever been asked to explain or defend your Catholic beliefs—perhaps on the papacy or on the adoration of the Virgin Mary—and given your best answer but walked away a little disappointed in yourself? You know in your heart the beauty, truth, and goodness of your Catholic faith. You know it is eminently reasonable. And yet, when you are challenged to explain why you believe such things, or show where those beliefs are in the Bible, or to show they are not mere "traditions of men," well, the words just don't seem to come. There is no reason to blame yourself. Our beliefs form a vast, interconnected network of the truths of reason and revelation, developed by Christ's Church under the guidance of the Holy Spirit for nearly 2,000 years. That's a lot to remember (and maybe your memory isn't the greatest, either). Still, wouldn't it be nice if there were a method to remember the key reasons for things like why we acknowledge the primacy of the pope, the adoration of Mary, or the proper roles of the Bible and Tradition in the one true faith? Many Christ-loving Protestants, after all, can cite, literally chapter and verse, scriptural texts that support their beliefs. Too bad the great Catholic theological doctors did not develop methods to help us remember the fundamentals of our faith. But hang on a minute—they did.

In the book *Memorize the Faith*, I showed how this Catholic art of memory can be used for the memorization of things like the Ten Commandments, the capital sins, the virtues, the beatitudes, the sacraments, the mysteries of the rosary, the exact order of all the 73 books in the Old and New Testaments, the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit, and more. It works wonderfully well. Let's dive into Pentecost so we know the gifts received on this great Solemnity and birthday of the Catholic church.

Here is a method called Loci to help us remember the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit. Imagine you are exploring your own memory mansion. Inside a banquet room sits a huge dining room table inside a gigantic ball room. You are pleasantly surprised when you see the table in the dining room it is filled with 7 gifts covered in prism wrapping paper, throwing prism reflections dancing off the walls of the room, and each package has your name on it. Gift #1: You notice above the table is a gigantic chandelier, made of crystals, throwing sparkling mini spotlights throughout the room, and each sparkle is a new idea. You are standing under these ideas scratching your head trying to understand them all.

Gift #1 is Understanding.

Gift #2 is an oversized thermometer hanging on the wall being licked by a cow in a silk bandana, "cow in silk" sounds close to "counsel" our Gift #2 is Counsel. Next is that thief from the movie "Home Alone" smiling at you with a sparkle in his eye (he wants to rob you) and a shine on his golden tooth. His gold tooth reminds you of a wisdom tooth, or

Gift #3 is Wisdom.

You look carefully to find a miniature climber the size of a "green army man" you played with as a kid. The climber is hanging with ropes from the edge of the table, and the climber calls out in a high pitched voice, "No Ledge" which reminds us of our

Gift #4, Knowledge.

You pull a chair out to sit at the dining room table, when you notice it is covered with a piping hot pumpkin pie fresh from the oven. The 5 th Gift of the Holy Spirit reminds you of piety.

Gift #5 is Piety. In the center of the Table you notice behind the 7 boxes of gifts is a hidden Lincoln logs fort built by a kid, which reminds you of the 6 th Gift of Fortitude.

Gift #6 is Fortitude.

Lastly you see a woman praying and trembling under the table on her knees, motioning you to be quiet with her finger pressed to her lips. She is filled with awe and trembling and reminds you of the 7 th gift of the Holy Spirit, the Fear of the Lord.

Gift #7 is Fear of the Lord.

This method of memorization comes from St Albert the Great called the method of Loci, where the location of the object sticks in your brain especially under weird circumstances. Once you know the order and location, you can walk forwards and backwards to recite this list of the 7 gifts of the Holy Spirit and always keep them correctly ordered. This method may be applied to lists, or apologetics or complex theories to explain the faith to your friends. Happy memorizing.

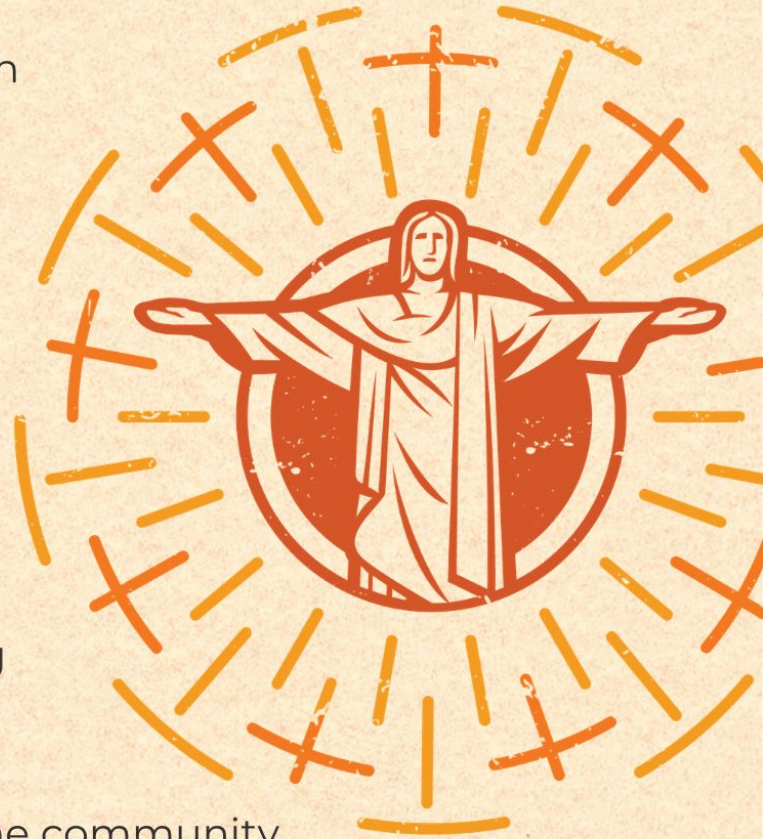
