Tuition Invoices

Tuition Invoices for the 25-26 school year are being sent home today. Please check your child's Wednesday folder for this information. If you have not applied for the Choice Scholarship, you will need to do so as soon as possible. Once you apply, we will be able to reflect the Scholarship on your invoice.

If you choose to pay in 10 monthly payments and have the payments pulled from your bank, you must fill out an ACH form. We have enclosed an ACH form in this week's Bear Facts.

Choice Scholarship Paperwork

If you have not signed your Choice Scholarship Paperwork, you will need to come into the office and sign. This needs to be done as soon as possible.

Cash Payments

If you plan to make any payment with cash, we ask that you please bring this payment into the front office. The front office will give a receipt for all cash payments. We will keep a copy of the receipt and this will be documentation that the payment has been made. If you do not receive a receipt for your payment, then we cannot verify the payment has been made.

School Masses

K-8 students will attend Mass every week on Wednesday. The masses are student led and a wonderful experience for our school community. Parents are welcome to attend our weekly masses.

Feast of the Assumption

The Feast of the Assumption, also known as the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, is a Catholic holy day celebrated on August 15th each year. It commemorates the belief that when Mary, the mother of Jesus Christ, died, her body was taken into heaven to be reunited with her soul.

Our school mass will be on Friday, August 15th and not on Wednesday. Again, parents are welcome to attend this Mass.



As many of you may have seen, we had major renovations done to the playground this summer. This was made possible by the donations from our last two Walk-a-thons. Mr. Garry Nokes led the scouts in removing the rest of the posts that were cemented in the ground. Before construction could begin on the new playground equipment, the land needed to be graded. This wouldn't have been possible without Frank Cahill, Joe Storz, and Tony Bucy who either loaned or borrowed all the equipment, which included tractors, augers, dump trailers, and other heavy equipment. Sean Weigel donated all the concrete from his company to secure the playground pieces. Drop Off and Pick Up Reminders

We have many new families joining our school this year, so this is a perfect time to go over how we do our morning drop off and afternoon pick up. Please see the diagrams attached. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to call the school office for clarification.


Morning Drop Off

- You may drop off your child on either side of the building regardless of grade level. Students are to come through the breezeway doors where they will be greeted by a faculty member.
- You MUST enter from Marshall Avenue, please do not enter from the front of the building off of Sherwood Ave.
- If you need to help your child out of the car and/or plan to walk them up to the breezeway doors, then you will
 need to park in an open parking spot before exiting your vehicle. DO NOT get out of your car in the car line.
- If you arrive after 7:50am, you will need to park out in the front of the building, walk your child into the building, then sign them in.
- If you are coming into the parking lot close to 7:50am to try and beat the bell, DO NOT just drop your child off and leave. It is imperative that you have made sure they made it it into the building. The doors will be locked at 7:50am, and we don't want any child stranded outside of the building unattended.

Afternoon Pick Up


- Any family with their youngest child in grades K-2 will pick up their child(ren) on the left side of the Annex building (closest to the Parish gym)
- Any family with their youngest child in grade 3-8 will pick up their child(ren) on the right side of the Annex building (the side by the school playground)
- Dismissal is at 2:40pm. Teachers will be outside dismissing students and directing traffic. Anyone not picked up by 2:50pm will be taken to After School Care and there will be a fee for this. It is very important that you make plans to have your child picked up by 2:50pm.
- Parents are asked not to park on Sherwood Avenue and have students come out front to meet them, as this
 creates a safety concern for the children who walk home. If student walkers are picked up by a car repeatedly
 in the front of the building, they will be dismissed to the car line. Parents may then pick up their child from the
 car line.
- Make sure you are pulling into the lanes as far up as you can. Once a lane is full, you will need to pick a
 different lane. Do not block the entrance into the parking lot as this creates a bottleneck, and we can't get
 all the cars in to park in the lanes.




