## **PROJECT HIGHLIGHT**



STEEL MARKETS



Some minor pricing increases are expected through the end of the year on Tubing and Beams, but the general expectation is that the New Year's Q1 pricing, which remains flat, will continue into 2024. That said, there is always potential for increases outside of demand due to the cost of production and lack of imports. There are some suggestions floating around that flat roll, plate, (and, therefore, tubing) seem to be moving in that direction.



Supply is good and demand is strong! Given the backlog and real project announcements, Q1-Q2 are looking very good. No supply issues currently exist. Mill capacities are healthy and run in the 80-85% range, depending on the mill and product. Most mills are running a 6-10-week rotation on products (varying on the section). Note that availability, but not necessarily capacity, could become an issue with the mills if multiple large projects launch at the same time. If availability becomes an issue, it may require orders to be placed 2-3 weeks earlier than they are now to ensure delivery.



Although the backlog for 2024 is already significant, capacity is not threatened. For most projects, we should continue to expect joist and deck deliveries approximately 14-16 weeks from award. However, tighter timelines and faster schedules are the new norm, and our suppliers have committed to adapting to meet the market demands we are seeing. As we approach the closing of 2023, we will see price increases in the joist and deck world from certain suppliers. Others are expected to follow suit. Although it is not likely that we will see a repeat of the extreme increase we saw in 2021, there is an expectation of more to come in the first half of 2024.

Cooper Steel is constantly looking for ways to supply our fabrication shop and employees with tools and processes to increase efficiencies, while still producing quality work. Our newest additions accomplish these initiatives, and we are excited to see the impact.
