Ladies Tuesday Bible Study will resume next Tuesday, September 15th at 10am in the church library. All ladies are welcome.

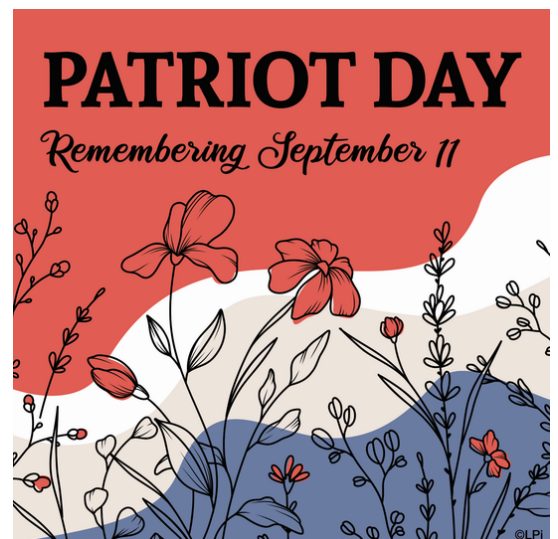
Flowers on the altar are placed in memory of John & Henrietta Mecke placed by Charles & Beth Mecke.
