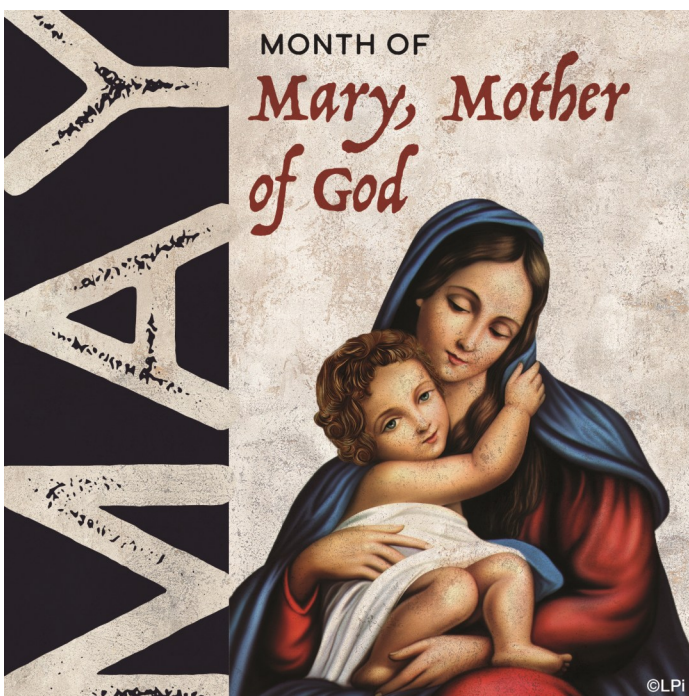
The church sign is in progress. Any donations may be made marked 'church sign' on check. Thank you for your support.
